Fires Reported in FireRMS

June 1, 2013, 1:45 a.m. - Called for a sofa fire on Gunson Street. Fire personnel arrived, found a sofa on fire in the roadway, put it out with tank water and moved it to the side of the road.

Training Reported in FireRMS

June 4, 5 and 6, 2013 - 8 a.m. to noon and 1:30-5:30 p.m. each day - Metro Building collapse training - Fire station 1 and 2 on duty personnel took turns at this training at a site in MTFD area. Fire personnel reviewed search, rescue, and shoring techniques. Lansing Fire Department and Meridian Township Fire Department were also in attendance. At the June 5th training the Michigan K-9 search team attended.

June 5, 2013, 9:00 a.m. 3 p.m. - Rescue Training – On duty Lieutenant attended TF-1 Search Team Training. Training involved information regarding the format of the team in the future, updating skill verification, review/teach the canine team ropes/knots, equipment and working with the search dogs in drills. This training took place at the MOB Center in Waterford, MI.
