### **Fires Reported in FireRMS**

June 27, 2013, 12:01 p.m. - East Lansing Fire was dispatched to a car fire on Gunson at Albert. Engine 11 was assigned to the call and responded with four personnel. Engine 11 arrived and found a Board of Water and Light vehicle in a parking area off of Albert at Gunson. The engine compartment was fully involved in fire with the passenger compartment charged with smoke. The doors to the vehicle were not locked and were opened by firefighters. Once the fire was knocked down the front area of the hood was cut with the K-12 saw to open it. Once open the fire was extinguished. There was a small amount of fire that had extended to the passenger area and that was also extinguished. The on duty EL fire inspector was called and responded to the scene. Lansing Fire investigative personnel also arrived to assist with the investigation.
