**Fires Reported in FireRMS – page 1 of 2**

August 25, 2013, 8:04 p.m. - Called for a possible structure fire. Bystander on scene stated that fire was visible. Command requested LFD B-41 for safety. Truck 12 assigned to fire attack group, Engine 11 assigned to vent group, Medic 121 assigned to RIT and Medic 12 assigned to rehab. Fire attack group attacked with an extinguisher and water and then reported the fire out. The vent group cleared the structure of smoke and RIT sent to search the residence. The EL Fire Marshal was called through dispatch.

August 26, 2013, 1:28 a.m. – East Lansing Fire was dispatched to a fire in the street on Bailey at Ann. Engine 11 was assigned to the call and responded with three personnel. They arrived on the scene and found a small couch in the street fully involved in fire. The engine crew used the inch and three quarter trash line to extinguish the fire with 50 gallons of water. The rest of the couch was removed from the street by the engine crew and put on the side of the road. Engine cleared the scene and returned to quarters.

August 26, 2013, 8:04 p.m. - We were dispatched to a cooking fire confined to the container. One unit was assigned to this incident. Three personnel responded. We arrived on scene and investigation and ventilation of the 3rd floor. The alarm was reset and the estimated property value and loss on this incident was \$100.

August 28, 2013, 3:50 a.m. - ELFD dispatched to East Shaw Lane for smoldering fire in a grassy area next to the road from an underground street light wires shorting out. Truck 12 responded emergent and arrived to find the MSU Physical Plant on scene waiting for the street light electrical personnel to arrive. The fire was out with some very light smoke from the ground hole. No exposures noted but did note that the ground was very wet from heavy rains. Truck 12 cleared.
