Fires Reported in FireRMS – page 1 of 2

August 3, 2013, 1:19 a.m. - Called for a chair fire at Orchard and Ann. Upon arrival found a chair in the roadway that was smoldering and firefighters extinguished with 10 gallons of water. They then moved the chair onto the curb and cleared the scene.

August 3, 2013, 6:06 p.m. - Called to the 1800 block of Swallow Court for a grass fire due to fireworks. Upon arrival grass had burned out and firefighters made sure it would not rekindle. There was about a 5' diameter burned area and ELPD were on the scene to investigate the shooting of fireworks that caused the fire. The fire department turned the scene over to police and then cleared.

August 4, 2013, 9:15 p.m. – A bystander stopped at Station 2 and advised that a tree was on fire by Chestnut and Shaw. Truck 12 advised dispatch and then went en route. Fire personnel arrived at the scene, set up command and investigated. They found a small area at the base of a tree that was on fire. They extinguished by the front jump line. No witnesses or problems noted at the scene and Truck 12 cleared.

August 8, 2013, 3:13 a.m. - Dispatched for mutual aid to assist MTFD for structure fire on DaySpring Court. East Lansing Engine 11 and Battalion 11 were initially dispatched and then dispatch added Medic 11 prior to exit. EL units reported to MTFD Command on scene. Engine 11 and Medic 11 assigned to access the garage via the front overhead door. Battalion 11 was assigned to side C and D to evaluate extension. Engine 11 reassigned to vent the roof and later assigned to overhaul the garage. Once assignments were complete EL units were cleared by MTFD Command.

Training Reported in FireRMS

August 6, 2013, 1:30-3:30 p.m. – Pumper Tender Operations – On duty personnel performed pump testing utilizing both Engine 11 and Truck 12 to test individuals. Participants performed the most basic engineering functions representing fire extinguishment and recall of basic hydraulics.

August 7, 2013, 1:30-4:00 p.m. – Pumper Operator - Pump training on MSU campus with Engine 11 and Truck 12 personnel.

August 8, 2013, 1:30-3:30 p.m. – Fire Streams – Pump training was held at MSU Lot 89. The training included pre connect large hand lines and hydrant supply. All personnel also pumped with Engine 11 and Truck 12.
