**Fires Reported in FireRMS – page 1 of 2**

August 9, 2013, 12:48 p.m. - ELFD was dispatched to Service and Farm Lane for a brush fire. Truck 12 responded emergent and upon arrival located a small (10x30 ft) area of burned brush along the north side of the railroad tracks near the intersection. Firefighters completed extinguishment with an H2O extinguisher. No further fire extension. MSUPD were on the scene and Truck 12 cleared.

August 10, 2013, 12:48 a.m. – EL Truck 12 cleared prior to a call and dispatched self to Victor Street for a couch fire. Upon arrival they found the EL Police Department on the scene and a couch in the end stages of fire. Firefighters extinguished and then overhauled the remaining wood to the side of the parking area. Fire personnel did not noticed anything unusual on the scene other than couch itself. The EL Fire Marshal was notified via cell and then Truck 12 cleared the scene and returned to station #2.

August 10, 2013, 1:19 a.m. – Called to a sofa fire in the middle of the street at the 500 block of Gunson. Engine 11 personnel used a garden hose off the side number 2 discharge to put the fire out and then cleared the scene.

August 11, 2013, 4:47 p.m. - ELFD was dispatched to the alley behind E. Grand River for a couch fire. Truck 12 responded emergent and arrived to find a couch next to a dumpster on fire with no exposures. The fire was extinguished with tank water/trash line and then Truck 12 cleared.

## **Fires Reported in FireRMS – page 2 of 2**

August 13, 2013, 9:32 p.m. - Called to Stonehedge Drive for a stove top fire that was out per the residents. Upon arrival firefighters found no fire or smoke. They did find fire and smoke damage from a pan on the stove top that had burned. The Thermal Imaging Camera showed nothing around the area. The resident explained that a pan of hot oil started to burn and they placed a wet towel on it to put it out. Fire personnel had informed the Fire Marshal and sent him four pictures related to the fire damage and the man's ID. He stated he would follow up the next day. The apartment staff was on the scene also. Engine 11 cleared the scene.
