Fires Reported in FireRMS – page 1 of 2

September 7, 2013, 2:09 a.m. – EL Fire was dispatched to the 1600 block of Burrows Avenue for a cooking fire confined to the container. One unit was assigned to this incident and 3 personnel responded. Upon arrival and investigation found this call was due to burned noodles on the stove top. Engine 11 crew ventilated the apartment and then cleared the scene.

September 7, 2013, 1:04 p.m. - Dispatched for a dumpster fire on Delta Court. Truck 12 responded emergent with 3 personnel on board. Upon arrival, had light odor of material burning but unable to locate the dumpster. Advised dispatch of the same. Fire personnel walked on foot and located a dumpster off Grand River. Truck 12 relocated, and advised dispatch there was a large dumpster with minimal material inside of it that was on fire. The dumpster was located close to a building but exposure was not an issue. Firefighters extinguished the fire and then gathered information from the individuals who called this fire in. It was unknown who or what started it. The dumpster had some charring to the exterior paint but the dumpster lid was intact and walls of dumpster do not appear to be damaged beyond function. Advised dispatch the fire was out. Truck 12 cleared and returned to quarters.

September 12, 2013, 9:50 p.m. ELFD was dispatched to a fire at the top of a pole located at Chandler and Coleman. One unit was assigned to this incident and 3 personnel responded. Firefighters arrived on the scene to find a fire at the top of a pole; they extinguished it and then cleared the scene. The cause of ignition was undetermined.

September 6, 2013 8:30-10:30 – Metro Confined Space Training – ELFD station 2 on duty personnel attended this training at Munn Ice Arena.

September 6, 2013 1-3 p.m. – Metro Confined Space Training – ELFD station 1 on duty personnel attended this training at Munn Ice Arena.

September 10, 2013, 1:30-3:30 p.m. – Fire Ground Management – All on duty station 1 and 2 personnel participated in this fire size up and initial fire ground actions training that was presented by the on duty Deputy Chief and Captain.

September 11, 2013, 1:30-3:30 p.m. – Fire Behavior - Discussed Sofa Super Store fire resulting in 9 fire fatalities in Charleston, SC in 2007. This case was presented by the on duty Deputy Chief with active discussion by all.

September 12, 2013, 2:30-4:00 p.m. – Firefighting Tactics – Station 2 on duty personnel studied firefighter tactics from IFSTA 5 and the ELFD SOG. Also, they studied the ACLS Protocols.
