December 7-8, 2013, from 11:11 p.m. to 4:29 a.m. - ELFD and multiple other agencies responded to several miscellaneous fires at various locations in conjunction with the MSU vs. Ohio State football game.

December 9, 2013 at 2:08 p.m. - East Lansing Fire was dispatched to a small fire next to a house and gas meter on Sunrise. Engine 11 was assigned to the call and responded with 3 personnel. Dispatch advised that the police were on the scene and that the fire was a trash can and that the fire was out. Engine 11 arrived at a two story residential structure with the trash can melted and the fire was out. Police stated when they arrived on scene the flames were near the gas meter and they used a dry chemical extinguisher to put it out. The Engine crew used a five gallon bucket full of water to make sure the fire was extinguished. The on-duty fire inspector was contacted and responded to the scene. The occupant also arrived and their information was taken as well. Engine 11 was cleared by the inspector returned to quarters.

December 10, 2013, 3:30-5:00 p.m. - Manipulative Driving Skills - A newer employee started their driver training by driving in the parking lot at DPW and then going out on the streets.

December 12, 2013 7:30-8:30 p.m. - Hazardous Materials Identification – 2 on duty personnel attended this class and reviewed sampling and testing procedures at LFD Station # 6.

December 12, 2013, 8:10-8:30 a.m. – Motor Vehicle Accident Scene Safety – All on duty station 2 personnel had a table top review of the Operating in Traffic SOG.
