Fires Reported in FireRMS - page 1 of 2

January 10, 2014, 8:48 p.m. – East Lansing Fire responded to a location on Gossard for a mutual aid request from Meridian Township Fire Department. It was a reported car fire that was fully involved and the car was in the carport. EL Firefighters arrived to find a car in the carport and the hood was open. Minimal flames were seen in the front passenger side of engine compartment. Fire personnel used a front jump line to extinguish the visible flames. They also soaked the engine compartment with water and cut the battery cables. After the fire was fully extinguished the scene was turned over to MTFD Battalion Chief 91 who took the vehicle owners information. East Lansing Engine 11 then cleared.

January 11, 2014, 1:55 a.m. - Responded to report of a couch fire in the alley behind a residence on Bogue. Found a couch and very little fire. Firefighters smothered the flame and then cleared.

January 13, 2014, 8:17 a.m. - Dispatched to MAC for a fire/smoke alarm. Advised en route that the occupants had burned toast. Upon arrival occupants advised that the house mother had reset the alarm panel. During the fire department investigation they found a light haze in the basement but no fire. This area was ventilated by Engine 11 fire personnel, information gathered and then cleared.

January 14, 2014, 5:53 a.m. – EL Battalion 11 was called to a fire on Roosevelt to assist Lansing Fire Department as their Safety Officer. However, he was cleared before leaving the building.

January 16, 2014, 10:49 p.m. – EL Fire was dispatched to a location on MAC for a fire alarm. Advised en route it was a false alarm with burnt popcorn in the microwave. Upon arrival found a strong smell of burnt popcorn but no fire or smoke. Firefighters reset the alarm to a normal operating mode.

January 14, 15 & 16 2014, 1:30-2:30 p.m. – EMS Trauma Class – All on duty personnel participated in EMS trauma training which consisted of KED, long boarding, and traction splinting.

January 16, 2014, 8:30-9:30 a.m. – Aerial Apparatus-Operations Training – 1 firefighter worked with another firefighter on Truck 12's check list, pump operations, ladder operations and non-emergency driving.
