



## City of East Lansing Fire Department Incident Report December 20-26, 2013

### **Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

December 24, 2013, 5:08 p.m. – East Lansing Engine 11 and Medic 11 responded to assist MTFD at a structure fire on Newman Road. Upon arrival the structure showed heavy smoke throughout and flames. Engine 11 was needed for water supply by drafting water from a port-a-tank to supply MTFD Truck and Engine. Medic 11 started an interior attack from the main doorway. At that location heavy smoke and the ceiling were being pulled and a 1-3/4” hand line was getting water to the crawl space. Shortly after starting there was a loss of the water supply two or three times. At this point the roof and crawl space were free burning throughout most of the house and there was a report that part of the roof had collapsed. There were 3 more tankers that arrived and there was better water supply to maintain the needed demand. The Incident Commander ordered to go defensive and use the ladder truck master stream. After the fire was darkened down the fire crews were rotated inside for salvage and overhaul operations. This went on for several hours. EL Medic 11 was cleared from the scene at 7:25 p.m. At 10:42 p.m. EL Engine 11 was cleared.

December 24, 2013, 5:22 p.m. - Dispatched to assist to MTFD on a generator fire on Woodcraft. Truck 12 en route with 3 on board and Battalion 11 en route as well. Dispatch advised that the generator was moved and not a threat to the structure. Firefighters were detoured reaching the house due to taped off areas and downed wires. Upon arrival, found the homeowner at the front of the house and dark smoke coming from behind it. Firefighters investigated and found a generator moderately involved within 8 feet of the house. Truck 12 personnel stretched hose and extinguished the generator and the wood that was in the vicinity. The back door to the house had peeled paint and the screen door had melted the lower half panel. The resident stated that they had run the generator on and off for the past 3 days. Today they decided to build a wooden base to go around it. The generator had 2 extension cords (burned out) running from it. The one went to a breaker box and that was shut off by the homeowner. The other was still plugged into an extension outlet and that was disconnected by fire personnel. Advised to have an electrician look into the one hooked to the breaker box. Truck 12 advised dispatch that the fire was out and cleared the scene

## **Fires Reported in FireRMS page 2 of 2**

December 24, 2013, 7:25 p.m. – EL Fire was dispatched to assist Meridian Township for a chimney fire on Starboard Drive. EL Truck 12 responded emergent with 3 on board. Lansing Fire Department had an engine en route also. East Lansing Battalion 11 had Truck 12 staged upon arrival and advised no smoke or fire so East Lansing units were cleared.
