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**Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

April 26, 2014, 5:35 a.m. – EL Fire was dispatched to a location on Service Road for a fully involved oil fire being fed by and air line. Updated information continued to support that an active fire was present and some people were evacuating while 2 were staying in the control room. Mutual aid was ordered for from Lansing Fire for 1 Engine, 1 Ladder and B-41. East Lansing Truck 12 arrived first and investigated. EL Battalion arrived and established command. East Lansing Engine 11 arrived and was assigned to lay into Truck 12. Lansing B-41 arrived and assisted with organizing the LFD crews. Lansing E-48 was assigned to assist in water supply; T-41 was assigned to RIT. EL Medic 11 was assigned to assist interior operations. Dispatch was advised to contact ORCBS of the situation. The control room was contacted and the equipment was de-energized. Ventilation was also addressed by the control room. EL Engine 11 reported that 8 plant personnel were in the control room and ordered to seek shelter there. Conditions were reported clear by face to face communication. As water supply was being set up along with the foam, division 2 called for straight water. Since water supply was not yet established the attack line was ordered to be charged from the tank water. The fire was reported under control shortly thereafter. EL Engine 11 and Lansing T-41 were assigned to secondary search of the structure. This ended up being oil residual fire and the power plant manager requested us to stand by throughout the morning in case some sparks from re-energizing equipment re-ignited. The oncoming EL Truck 12 crew and EL Battalion 11 were called to relieve the off going shift. Command was turned over to the EL Acting Battalion.

April 26, 2014, 11:44 p.m. – EL Fire was dispatched to a location on Grand River for a cooking fire confined to the container. One unit with 3 personnel responded. They arrived at the scene and extinguished the small fire.

## **Fires Reported in FireRMS page 2 of 2**

May 1, 2014, 12:43 a.m. – EL Truck 12 was dispatched to a fire in the alley way of Elizabeth and MAC. Fire personnel were updated by dispatch en route that police were unable to locate and believed the fire to be in the 300 block of Elizabeth. Truck 12 arrived to find a small contained fire on the sidewalk. The occupants were burning sticks and wood in small fire-pit and did not have an approved fire permit. The occupants extinguished the fire and were cooperative in complying with fire personnel wishes. They questioned how to receive a burning permit and they were advised to follow up with the process at fire station 1. The EL Fire Marshal was contacted via phone for notification of the issue. Truck 12 cleared the scene and returned to station 2.

May 1, 2014, 7:56 p.m. - Called to an alarm sounding at an apartment complex on Hillcrest Avenue due to the resident left the stove top on and burned some food in a pan. Upon arrival firefighters found light smoke and no fire. They opened some windows to ventilate and cleared the scene.

## **Training Reported in FireRMS**

April 29, 30, and May 1, 2014, 1:30-2:30 p.m. – Operations – All on duty personnel reviewed chest pain protocols, were trained on the new modem for Lifepack 12 and how to send ECG strips to the hospitals. All individuals demonstrated the ability to perform the skill.
