April 19, 2014, 9:21 a.m. – EL Fire was toned out to a location on Glenhaven for a truck on fire with construction material in it. Upon arrival firefighters found a large cargo van from a construction company fully involved with fire in the back cargo area of the vehicle. The vehicle was in the driveway and was full of equipment and supplies. Firefighters used a 1-3/4 speed lay and tank water plus a dry chemical fire extinguisher to put the fire out. They also had a water supply ready from the hydrant but did not need it. Truck 12 was called to respond for some equipment and standby. The EL Fire Marshal was called, arrived and was given a report. Fire units then cleared the scene.

April 22, 2014, 1:14 p.m. – EL was dispatched to Trowbridge and 127 for a grass fire. Truck 12 responded, arrived, set up command and investigated. No other problems were noted in the area. Met with a railroad representative who stated workers were welding, ignited grass and put the fire out with a fire extinguisher. The area was checked by fire personnel with no other problems noted. Truck 12 then cleared the scene.

April 23, 2014, 2:12 p.m. – ELFD was dispatched to a call for trash burning on Farm Lane. Upon arrival found MSUPD on the scene and had discharged a fire extinguisher on the fire but flames were still visible. The fire was contained in a trash can and firefighters poured a bucket of 5 gallons of water on the fire to put it out completely. They then cleared scene and returned to the fire station.

April 23, 2014, 7:23 p.m. – EL Fire Department was toned out to Kalamazoo and Marigold area. Upon arrival fire department extinguished an unsupervised campfire and then Truck 12 cleared.

April 22, 2014, no time indicated - High/Low Angle Rescue – On duty fire station 1 personnel went to Lansing Fire Department station 8 for a crane high angle demonstration.

April 22, 2014, 9:00-10:30 a.m. – High/Low Angle Rescue – On duty fire station 2 personnel went to Lansing Fire Department station 8 for Metro Rope Training.
