**Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

June 6, 2014, 1:59 p.m. – EL Fire responded to a location on Abbot for a fire in the woods. Upon arrival found several books in the woods north of the Library that had been burned. The fire was out and Engine 11 cleared.

June 14, 2014, 6:32 p.m. – ELFD was called by neighbors for an illegal burn at the corner of Highland and Westview. Upon arrival firefighters found the occupant had a campfire in the back yard, not in an enclosed burner and had no permit. The occupant put the fire out and was advised of the process to get burn permit. Fire personnel cleared the scene and returned to the station.

June 15, 2014, 4:33 p.m. - ELFD was dispatched to a grass fire on Louis Street. Truck 12 responded emergent and arrived to find a 4x6' area of wood chips smoldering and smoking. Firefighters extinguished with tank water and saturated the area as well. Truck 12 then cleared.

June 17, 2014, 9:23 a.m. – EL Engine 11 was dispatched to an electrical line arcing from a tree branch on Ramblewood. Engine 11 requested the utility company to come to the scene. Arrived to find nothing showing at the residence. Fire personnel met with the resident and they showed fire personnel where a tree branch had fallen onto a main line in the rear of the residence and the main line was still intact. The branch was not actively burning and Engine 11 confirmed with dispatch that the utility company had been contacted. Fire personnel affirmed that multiple residences were without power and remained on the scene until the utility company arrived. Once they did the scene was turned over to them. Engine then 11 cleared and returned to station #1.

## **Fires Reported in FireRMS page 2 of 2**

June 18, 2014, 4:33 p.m. – EL Truck 12 called to assist Meridian Township Fire Department at a location on Madison. They needed a ladder to get on to the roof and search for a possible attic fire. EL Battalion 11 responded also to supervise Truck 12's operations. The fire was found in the attic by Meridian fire personnel. EL firefighters then pulled some ceilings out on the balcony until relieved by Meridian Township Firefighters. EL Truck 12 was cleared and returned to service. EL Battalion 11 also cleared.
