



## City of East Lansing Fire Department 2-Week Incident Report September 19 - October 2, 2014

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### **Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

September 19, 2014, 11:18 p.m. - ELFD dispatched to East Grand River, in the alley for a dumpster fire. Truck 12 responded emergency. Upon their arrival they found a well involved dumpster with sofas on fire, one vehicle in close proximity as only an exposure. The fire was extinguished with tank water. The EL Fire Marshal was contacted and advised that the vehicle had melted materials from burning debris along the entire driver's side. Truck 12 then cleared.

September 20, 2014, 1:25 a.m. - Called in by EL Police about a couch fire in the street at Milford and Ann. Engine 11 fire personnel put it out with a small amount of water from a garden hose. They then cleared for another call.

September 28, 2014, 2:11 p.m. - Called for a dumpster fire on Grand River. Truck 12 responded, arrived, established command and extinguished the fire with their front 1-3/4" line. They then picked up their equipment, terminated command, cleared and returned to station 2.

### **Training Reported in FireRMS**

September 23, 2014, 9 a.m.-1:00 p.m. - Other Rescue Training - One of the on duty Captains is a member of the TF-1 Green Team out of Waterford, MI. They are a Technical Search Specialist who participated in a review of the last drill that was performed at Mt. Holly Ski Resort. They reviewed upcoming drills to be performed, expectations, updated task books and reviewed all the equipment used within their team. Also, the truck used to move the Technical Search Team had its equipment gutted, cleaned and organized.

September 23, 2014, 1:00-3:45 p.m. - Emergency Response Safety - All on duty personnel had a tour of the MSU Power Plant and reviewed their emergency response actions.

September 23, 2014, 7:00-7:30 p.m. - Personnel Evaluations - One on duty firefighter was tested out for their 2 year mark. This involved protocols, SOGs, maps and administration items. They passed successfully.

## **Training Reported in FireRMS page 2 of 2**

September 24, 2014, 8 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. – Building Collapse – One on duty Captain had a Green Team drill which involved concrete cutting with the ring saws, gas powered concrete chain saws and the Stanley hydraulic saws. The training was at the operating engineers training site in Howell, MI.

September 24, 2014, 1:00-3:30 p.m. - Pre-Incident Planning – All on duty personnel had a walk through of the MSU Power Plant and MSU Laundry.

September 30, 2014, 1:30-3:00 p.m. – Donning/Wearing/Using SCBA – All on duty personnel had a short lecture covering vent-enter-search, communication, tools, thermal imaging camera, and radio traffic as pertaining to following a hose line into a hazardous environment. Crews then broke into companies and followed a hose line up and down stairs, through two confining tubes and into a room to perform a vent-enter-search procedure.

October 2, 2014, no time listed – Pumper Operations – All on duty personnel had a class on pump operations and hydraulics given by an on duty firefighter.
