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**Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

September 13, 2014, 10:50 a.m. – EL Fire was called for a structure fire on Coolidge and State Road with the police on the scene reporting it was a fully involved structure fire. Battalion 11 responded from station 2 could see heavy smoke visible from Coolidge and Grand River. Upon his arrival found a large 4,000-5,000 square ft. vacant house with about a 2,000 ft. long driveway. Fire units responded and upon arrival they had to cut the cable blocking the driveway and ask EL police to shut down State Road for water supply. After making their way up the over grown driveway, firefighters found the house fully involved with a section of the roof collapsing and reported that this would be a defensive fire. Requested that Medic 11 crew hand lay all of our 5 inch hoses down the driveway to set up relay pumping from other arriving units. Had dispatch call the on duty fire inspector to the scene. Battalion 11 requested an engine and truck from LFD. Firefighters layed a 2 ½” line and used tank water to try to and knock down some of the fire. Once a water supply was established, added two more 2-1/2” lines. Several fire crews applied water for hours. The owner of the house helped with overhaul by using a Skytrek fork truck knocking walls into the basement while at the same time, fire personnel applied water to the hot spots. After the fire was out, cleaned up equipment and cleared the scene.

September 14, 2014, 2:26 a.m. - Called to a small fire in the middle of the street on Cornell. Engine 11 responded and firefighters found a bed frame burning and put the fire out with a garden hose. Engine 11 then cleared the scene.

**Training Reported in FireRMS**

September 16, 2014, 8:30-11:30 a.m. and 1:30-4:00 p.m. - Metro Confined Space Training on MSU Campus – one station went in the morning and then the other station went in the afternoon. Fire personnel performed a simulated rescue of two victims in a water reservoir.
