Incident Report
October 31 – November 13, 2014**

Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 3

November 2, 2014, 1:20 a.m. - Dispatched to a couch fire on Louis St. T-12 arrived at the scene to find a couch on fire next to a fully involved dumpster fire. No exposures. T-12 extinguished the fire with the front jump line. The dumpster was full to the top with plywood panels, carpet and scrap pieces of lumber. More fire was noted when lumber was removed from the dumpster and that fire was extinguished also. No other problems or suspicious items were noted at the scene. The EL Fire Marshal was contacted and advised of the situation. T-12 cleared the scene.

November 2, 2014, 8:15 a.m. – Dispatched for dumpster fire on Louis St. T-12 en route emergent with 3 on board. Responded to the same location last night for a dumpster fire. Arrived to find a dumpster smoldering and a trace of fire inside. Extinguished using approximately 500 gallons of water and then and overhauled. Advised dispatch of our findings and then T-12 cleared.

November 2, 2014, 4:28 p.m. - Dispatched for an illegal burn on Lilac. T-12 responded emergent with 3 on board. Arrived on the scene and met by an ELPD officer who stated the residents were burning boxes. Firefighters found a small circle on the ground in the back yard surrounded by small and medium rocks to contain area. The smoldering ashes were all that was left. The individuals stated that they did not know they could not burn and were very apologetic. Fire personnel explained the burning rules for the city. Once the ashes were extinguished and information was collected, T-12 cleared.

November 3, 2014, 10:32 a.m. - Called to Whitehills Drive to investigate a fire that was reported by a DPW worker. ELPD also advised that they had several reports of students from the high school starting fires in the area. Upon our arrival the fire was out and firefighters found an old tree stump, leaves, branches and some paper that had been burned. The Fire Marshal was also advised of the situation. ELPD was going to follow up at the high school main office and try to identify the students.

Fires Reported in FireRMS page 2 of 3

November 3, 2014, 10:22 p.m. - ELFD dispatched to E. Grand River for a pizza oven fire that was out at time of dispatch. T-12 responded emergency and arrived to find nothing showing and investigated. Fire personnel met with the manager who stated that the deep fryer grease was on fire and extinguished by them prior to our arrival. There was no smoke in the building or obvious damage to kitchen area. There was however, dry chemical residue all over twin fryers, floor, and counter tops in the kitchen. The manager had a deep cough from the dry chemical so M-12 was requested to evaluate. T-12 crew provided BLS care until they arrived. Advised the staff not to sell any more food product and contacted the EL Fire Marshal who will be in to investigate with the Ingham County Health Department in the morning. The business was closed until the fire marshal completed an investigation.

November 8, 2014, 8:47 p.m. - Dispatched to a fire in a contained fire pit on Harrison Road. T-12 arrived at the scene, set up command and investigated. They found an unattended fire pit smoldering and they extinguished the fire. No other problems at the scene so T-12 cleared.

November 9, 2014, 12:05 a.m. - ELFD dispatched to Ann and Division for a chair on fire in the road. E-11 responded emergency and arrived to find a chair burning in the road but no exposures. The fire was extinguished with tank water and then E-11 cleared.

November 9, 2014, 12:08 a.m. - Dispatched for an unknown item in the roadway on fire at Oak and Beal. T-12 arrived at the scene to find a fully involved couch fire. The fire was extinguished and there were no witnesses or other problems noted at the scene. T-12 cleared the scene.

November 9, 2014, 1:48 a.m. - Dispatched for a couch fire in the road on Cedar. T-12 arrived at the scene to find a fully involved couch fire. The fire was extinguished and a can of Kingsford Charcoal Fluid was found on the couch. No witnesses at the scene or other problems noted. The EL Fire Inspector was contacted and advised of the situation. T-12 cleared the scene.

November 9, 2014, 3:28 a.m. - ELFD dispatched to Spartan and Albert for couch on fire in the road. E-11 responded emergency and arrived to find a couch well consumed by fire burning in road with no exposures. Firefighters extinguished it with tank water and then cleared.

November 11, 2014, 10:56 p.m. - E-11 was dispatched to assist MTFD with a structure fire on Canoga. E-11 downgraded to normal traffic per MTFD BC. E-11 cancelled prior to arrival by MTFD and then E-11 cleared and returned to the station.

Training Reported in FireRMS

November 4, 2014, 1:30-2:45 p.m. - Apparatus Inspections & Maintenance - New Hires taken through E-11 and the Rescue to show them equipment location, proper starting techniques for the power tools and use of equipment on the rig.

November 4, 2014, 4:25-5:00 p.m. - Emergency Response Safety - On duty fire officer watched a video describing proper donning/doffing of PPE for Ebola contamination. The video also described the proper PPE to be used.

November 5, 2014, 9-11 a.m. - Respirator Fit Test - A few on duty personnel went to MSU for N-95 fit testing.

November 5, 2014, 1:30-2:30 p.m. – Water Rescue – All on duty personnel had reviewed some water rescue techniques.

November 12, 2014, 1:30-3:00 p.m. – Medical Treatment – All on duty personnel had a class on the effects and hazards of Carbon Dioxide. Plus they had SCBA and rig training with a new hire.
