**Fires Reported in FireRMS**

November 14, 2014, 3:15 p.m. – EL Fire was called for fire alarm activation on Farm Lane. Truck 12 responded, arrived, established command and investigated to find that a person was cooking a sweet potato in the microwave and left it in too long. It burned setting off the smoke detector in the room. No fire was noted and the smoke had self vented. A firefighter then reset the main panel while the fire officer gathered information. Command was then terminated and Truck 12 cleared and returned to station 2.
