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**Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

December 9, 2014, 5:03 p.m. – EL Fire Department Battalion 11 was called by Lansing Fire Department Battalion 41 to assist them and be a safety officer at a fire scene on Conners Avenue. EL Battalion 11 arrived was assigned to monitor Lansing Fire T-49 on the roof cutting vent holes. No safety issues noted. The fire was extinguished and EL was cleared by Lansing Command.

December 10, 2014, 10:56 a.m. - East Lansing Fire was dispatched to a structure fire on Woodland Pass. A box alarm assignment was dispatched a total of 11 personnel responded. Battalion 11 arrived at a one and a half story office building with nothing visible from the exterior. He assigned Engine 11 as interior investigation team and Medic 11 as RIT. All other unit advised to stand by apparatus. Interior asked for another crew to help investigate. Truck and Medic 12 crews assigned to that task. Truck 12 radioed that they had found where someone had thrown a cigarette butt next to the building. Medic 11 used positive pressure ventilation and removed the light smoke in the building. There was some damage to the plastic/rubber waterproofing seal at the foundation. All units except for Engine 11 cleared and returned. The on-duty fire inspector was contacted and responded to the scene. Battalion 11 cleared and returned to quarters.

**Training Reported in FireRMS**

December 11, 2014, 1:30-2:30 p.m. – First Responder Operations – All on duty personnel had a 1 hour review of several hazardous material monitors.

December 11, 2014, 3:30-4:00 p.m. – Confined Space Rescue Awareness – 4 on duty personnel reviewed the confined space bag and procedures for operations.
