



## City of East Lansing Fire Department Incident Report December 12-18, 2014

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### **Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

December 12, 2014, 7:24 p.m. - ELFD was dispatched to a stove fire in an apartment on Reniger. Truck 12 and Battalion 11 responded emergent to find nothing showing. T-12 investigated and found that occupants were cooking with hot oil on the range top that caught fire. They then moved the hot pan to the sink and turned on the water causing the fire to flare. The fire was out on arrival and there was no damage to the range, counters or any of the kitchen fixtures. The smoke vented out an open window and the alarm panel reset to normal. Reniger command terminated and Truck 12 cleared.

December 17, 2014, 4:19 p.m. - ELFD Truck 12 was called for a fire in a bus at Michigan and Grand River. Upon arrival the bus was not smoking or on fire but had an oil line that burst spraying oil on the exhaust causing smoke. There was oil on ground and firefighters put peat sorb on it and bus maintenance came to get the bus. Fire personnel cleared the scene and returned to the station.

### **Training Reported in FireRMS**

December 15, 16 and 17, 2014, 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. - Aerial Operator Training - All on duty personnel attended the training on the new fire rig. The training was held at the MSU Pavilion. Fire personnel went over the operation and usage of the new fire quint. There was a morning classroom portion touching on the overall safety and operation of the aerial unit. The afternoon session was hands on application of operation of the aerial unit and familiarization with the driver/operator controls.

December 18, 2014, 1-3:00 p.m. - Pump Operator Hydraulics - One on duty firefighter had training with Engine 11 on pump operations.

December 18, 2014, 3:30-5:45 p.m. - Operations - One new firefighter had his one month test and EMS test for Tri County.
