December 19, 2014 to January 1, 2015**

Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2

December 22, 2014, 10:06 a.m. – East Lansing Fire was dispatched to assist Meridian Township Fire Department with a house fire on Kenosha Trail. EL Battalion 11 arrived at the scene, reported to Meridian Fire Command and assisted them with fire tactics and safety. EL Truck 12 was assigned to ventilation and EL Medic 12 was assigned RIT. Once the fire was under control, MTFD command cleared all ELFD units from the scene.

December 24, 2014, 2:47 a.m. – ELFD was dispatched to South Shore Drive for an oven fire with occupants evacuating. Dispatch assigned Metro 1 for TAC, and advised that boxes in oven were burning inside oven. Update by dispatch that the police were on the scene, reporting no fire, only smoke in apartment. On arrival, EL Battalion 11 established command and found nothing visible. Assigned Engine 11 to investigate, and had all station 2 units stage on Coolidge Rd. The Engine 11 Captain reported there was no fire, only needed ventilation and that Engine 11 fire personnel could handle it. Cleared Station 2 units and passed command to Engine 11. The occupant stated that the fire alarm sounded initially and then went off again. They had pre-heated the oven to bake and forgot about the pizza boxes which caught on fire. No damage was noted to the structure. There seemed to be discoloration of the oven top and nothing further. E-11 contacted EL fire prevention with information gathered. E-11 crew ventilated apartment, advised the occupant to wait until morning to vacuum up residual byproducts and to follow-up with a call to maintenance for further clean-up or issues.

December 31, 2014, 11:33 p.m. - Dispatched to N. Harrison for a chimney fire. EL Battalion 11 went en route and asked for a TAC channel. Upon his arrival at the scene he found a two story residential with embers visible from the chimney. Engine 11 was assigned interior investigation, Medic 11 to RIT and Truck 12 and Medic 12 were advised to stage at Grand River and Harrison. Engine 11 advised that the fire was contained in the chimney. Truck 12 was assigned to ladder the roof and drop chimney (extinguishing bags) bombs. Engine 11 and Truck 12 advised that the fire was out. Engine 11 advised no fire extension or damage to the structure. The EL Fire Marshal and Inspector were contacted and advised of the situation. Truck 12, Medic 12, and Medic 11 were cleared and command was passed to Engine 11.

December 23, 2014, 1:30-3:30 p.m. - Pump Operator Hydraulics – All fire station 2 personnel went over pump operations with the new fire truck.

December 26, 2014, 4-4:30 p.m. – Aerial Operator – On duty Captain set up and maneuvered new aerial truck.

December 27, 2104, 4:30-5:00 p.m. - Pump Operator Hydraulics - On duty Captain went through pump operations on the new truck.

December 28, 2014, 1:30-2:30 p.m. – Pumper Operator – Three on duty personnel had pumper operation class on the new truck.

December 29, 2014, 11:30-1:30 p.m. – Pumper Operator – Five personnel ran through individually the pump operation and flowing water on the new truck.

December 30, 2014, 8:30-4:30 p.m. Pumper Operator – Ten on duty personnel had pump operation on the new truck and classroom on pump equipment.
