Fires Reported in FireRMS

February 21, 2015, 12:08 p.m. - T-11 was dispatched to a fire alarm at Burcham Hills. Dispatch updated that food in microwave caught fire, set off the alarm and the fire was reported as out by employees. T-11 responded non-emergency and arrived to find nothing showing. Firefighters found the alarm panel and silenced it with it showing that there was fire detector activation on the 2nd floor D wing. The fire crew investigated to find an employee in the hallway establishing ventilation. The occupant stated they were using the microwave and caught fire to paper on a muffin. The microwave was unplugged upon our arrival and no visible smoke in the area just the smell of burnt food. T-11 began ventilation in hallway to help clear the smell. The fire alarm was reset to normal operation and T-11 cleared the scene.
