Fires Reported in FireRMS

March 10, 2015, 6:26 p.m. – ELFD was dispatched to Phoebe Lane for a stove fire. Fire department units arrived to find a 2 story structure, nothing visible from the exterior and T-11 was assigned to investigate. Once inside firefighters reported no fire. The occupant had fries in the oven and says they caught on fire. However, the fries were not burnt and no charring to the oven area or smell of smoke in the house. Battalion cleared station #2 rigs and then all other rigs cleared.

March 10, 2015, no time logged – Pumps and Components – All on duty personal went over pump and truck operations.

March 11, 2015, 1:30-2:00 p.m. – Respirator Fit Test – 2 on duty personnel went to MSU EHS to get their fit tests for their SCBA and N95 masks.

March 11, 2015, 2:30-3:30 p.m. – Elevated Master Stream – 3 on duty personnel had training on T-11. Elevated the ladder connected to a fire hydrant and flowed water using the master stream and booster line.
