Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 3

March 27, 2015, 1:29 p.m. - ELFD was dispatched to the 600 block of Bogue for a trash can fire on the sidewalk. T-12 responded emergency and arrived to find a metal trash can smoking just off the parking area. The fire was extinguished with a water can and custodial services were advised to remove the can from service due to damage. T-12 then cleared.

March 28, 2015, 12:23 a.m. - ELFD was dispatched to Victor and River for trash burning in the road. T-12 responded emergency and arrived to find the remains of burnt trash in the road. EL Police had discharged a dry chemical extinguisher. EL Fire completed the extinguished with water and then cleared.

March 28, 2015, 12:34 a.m. - EL Fire was called for a fire in the alley in the 400 block of Abbot Road. T-11 responded, arrived and found a couch that had been lit on fire but extinguished by two extinguishers from bystanders. Firefighters hosed the couch down and then tossed it in the dumpster it was sitting next to. There was a utility pole that was also scorched, but did look structurally sound. T-11 then cleared and returned to service.

March 28, 2015, 12:56 a.m. - EL Fire was called to Park Lane and Elizabeth for a fire in the road. T-11 responded and extinguished the fire. Moved the debris to the side of the road, cleared and returned to station 1.

March 29, 2015, 10:15 a.m. - EL Fire units were dispatched to a possible structure fire on Cambria. T-11 arrived to find nothing showing from a 2 story apartment building. They began investigation and found the apartment clear of smoke but strong smell of burnt food. Upon investigation ask the homeowner about the situation and they stated that they left for a couple of minutes and came home to find apartment 1st floor filled with smoke. Fire personnel found food in microwave that was burnt. Homeowner stated a 5 year old child must have put something in microwave without them knowing. T-11 advised command to hold all incoming units and advised of the situation. T-11 remained to gather information and notified the on call fire investigator. T-11 then terminated command and returned to station #1.

Fires Reported in FireRMS page 2 of 3

March 29, 2015, 4:57 p.m. - Responded to a report of a couch on fire on Kedzie. Arrived to the area and ELPD signaled us to the alley West of Kedzie. Found a couch actively burning and pulled the front jump line and extinguished the fire. Shoveled debris out of the roadway and then cleared.

March 29, 2015, 5:12 p.m. - While on the road EL Fire responded to a couch fire. Arrived to the area and met with ELPD at the intersection and found a chair frame actively burning. Pulled the front jump line and extinguished the fire. Moved the debris out of the roadway and cleared the scene.

March 29, 2015, 10:45 p.m. - ELFD dispatched to the 400 block of Michigan in the parking lot for unknown fire. T-12 responded emergency and arrived to find in the vehicle parking lot a small area of burned substance, no exposures. Extinguished the fire and then cleared.

March 29, 2015, 10:47 p.m. – EL T-11 was dispatched to a couch on fire in roadway in the 500 block of Park Lane. Firefighters arrived to find the EL Police on the scene with a fully involved couch in roadway. T-11 extinguished the couch and then overhauled debris to the sidewalk area. T-11 contacted the fire prevention bureau and then cleared the scene.

March 29, 2015, 11:17 p.m. - ELFD was dispatched to Virginia and Beech for a couch on fire. T-12 responded emergency and arrived to find the remains of a couch in the road burning and no exposures. Firefighters extinguished the fire and then cleared.

April 1, 2015, 1:55 a.m. – EL Fire was dispatched for a couch fire at Frye and Stoddard. T-12 responded emergent with 3 on board. They arrived on the scene to find a couch and bike $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way extinguished. Established command and then extinguished with several buckets of water. Advised dispatch of the same, terminated command, cleared and returned to quarters.
