### **Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 3**

April 3, 2015, 9:12 a.m. - Dispatched for a car fire at either at 127 S and Trowbridge Rd. T-12 en route emergent with 3 on board. Fire personnel arrived on the scene of a car fire that was primarily in the engine compartment. They then advised dispatch of their findings and established command. T-12 blocked the highway, placed cones and then extinguished the fire. The EL Fire Investigator was already on the scene upon the fire rigs arrival and had collected driver/car information. Once the fire was out, removed the drivers belongings and delivered to them in attempt to avoid further smoke damage. A tow truck arrived and assisted in minor clean up and then the car was towed. T-12 terminated command and cleared the scene.

April 4, 2015, 8:26 p.m. - E-11 was dispatched to Spartan for a couch fire that was in the road. E-11 arrived to find a fully involved couch with no exposures. The crew extinguished the fire and then overhauled to the sidewalk area. E-11 cleared the scene and enroute to another fire.

April 4, 2015, 8:30 p.m. – ELFD was called to a couch fire in the street on Kedzie. T-11 crew put it out with the front reel line and then cleared the scene.

April 4, 2015, 8:33 p.m. - E-11 was dispatched to fire outside of a structure on Grove. E-11 arrived to find police units on the scene and they had extinguished the sofa prior to our arrival. E-11 found a propane torch nearby and confiscated it. The fire crew doused the sofa with water and cleared the scene.

April 4, 2015, 8:34 p.m. – EL Fire was called for a couch that was intentionally set on fire and was in the middle of street on Oak. Firefighters arrived and extinguished the fire and then moved the couch out of the road and cleared the scene.

April 4, 2015, 8:52 p.m. - E-11 was dispatched to fire at Forest and Oakhill. The Ingham County Sheriff's Department was on the scene of a fully involved couch fire. The E-11 crew extinguished the fire and removed the couch from the roadway. They then cleared the scene and returned to station one.

### **Fires Reported in FireRMS page 2 of 3**

April 4, 2015, 9:35 p.m. – EL Fire was called to a mattress fire at Oakhill and Evergreen. Upon arrival one side of the mattress was completely burned up. The T-11 crew put the fire out with the front reel line and before they cleared the scene MSP had a person in custody related to the fire.

April 4, 2015, 9:39 p.m. – ELFD was called for a couch fire in the road at Victor and River. T-12 responded and arrived to find the smoldering remains of a burnt chair. Police had attempted to extinguish it with some dry chemical extinguishers and put the majority of it out. Firefighters applied about 5 gallons of water to it to make sure it was completely out. They then moved it to the side of the road. It did damage the road leaving scorched asphalt and about a 12' divot in the asphalt in the middle of the road. T-12 then cleared and returned to station 2.

April 4, 2015, 10:30 p.m. - Dispatched to a fire outside on Charles. En route dispatch stated EL Police were on the scene stating that the fire was almost out. Firefighters arrived to find a pile of embers in the driveway behind the residence. They used a pail of water to extinguish the embers and a shovel to stir water into the pile.

April 4, 2015, 11:11 p.m. - Dispatched to a couch fire at Ann and Durand. Enroute, dispatch stated that the EL Police Department was on Ann with a couch on fire in the roadway. Fire personnel arrived and extinguished the couch with a jump line. They then moved the debris off the roadway and onto grass.

April 5, 2015, 12:08 a.m. - Dispatched to a couch on fire at Gunson and Ann. Arrived to find ELPD out with a couch on fire in the roadway. Extinguished the fire with the jump line and then moved the debris out of the roadway and onto grass.

April 5, 2015, 12:27 p.m. - Called for a couch fire. T-12 responded, arrived to find a small wood pile in the middle of the road at Kedzie and Grand River with an arm chair burning also. Firefighters extinguished the fire which left a large divot in the road from the fire that damaged the road. T-12 notified dispatch to let PACE know it needed to be picked up. T-12 then cleared and returned to station 2.

April 5, 2015, 6:39 a.m. - T-11 was dispatched to couch fire in roadway at Sunset and Oakhill. T-11 arrived to find a couch on fire so the firefighters extinguished it and then overhauled it to the sidewalk area. No obvious individuals involved. Remnants of spray cans and a couch remained. T-11 cleared the scene and returned to station one.
