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**Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

June 16, 2015, 9:49 p.m. – ELFD was called to Cambria for a grease fire on the stove top. The resident had a lid on the pan prior to our arrival. Upon arrival we had little smoke and small amount of flames around the lid. The pan was still hot and we moved it to the parking lot and used a dry chemical fire extinguisher on it. Firefighters let it cool down and later cooled it down more with a garden hose. The only damage noted was to the pan, lid and dish towels. Truck 11 then cleared the scene.

July 18, 2015 10:24 p.m. – EL Battalion 11 was dispatched to assist Lansing Fire Department on a structure fire on Kalamazoo. Upon arrival he reported to command. The fire appeared to be out, so he did a short walk around the structure and then advised command that fire and smoke was clear. Lansing command released him shortly after that.

**Training Reported in FireRMS**

July 17 and 18, 2015, 1-3:30 p.m. – Vehicle Extrication – All on duty personnel had an hour of class room training and then manipulative drills cutting up vehicles using extrication tools and methods.

July 18, 2015, 7:30-9:00 p.m. – Operation Update – All on on duty station 2 personnel reviewed operational procedures for the new Rapid Ready Rescue Response Chairs and then practiced their operations.
