Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2

August 31, 2015, 7:16 p.m. - East Lansing Fire was dispatched to a trash can fire in front of the 300 block of Michigan. Truck 12 was assigned to the call and responded with three personnel. Truck 12 arrived and found the same next to a bus stop smoking. Firefighters opened the lid and found a smoldering trash bag. Firefighters used a garden hose to extinguish the fire. The on-duty fire inspector was contacted via phone and advised of the call.

September 1, 2015, 12:12 p.m. – East Lansing Truck 11 was toned out to a fire alarm at a residence on MAC. The occupant called and stated that they were cooking food on the stove and set off the alarm. Truck 11 responded non-emergency and arrived to find the home occupied with the alarm not sounding. Fire personnel investigated to find maintenance from the management company stating they had reset the fire alarm system. Fire personnel impressed upon them that they were not to reset fire alarms and that in the future the fire department would reset the system. Truck 11 investigated to find the occupant still cooking chicken on the stove. Fire personnel also noted that the fire alarm panel was in normal operation. They also locked the panel as it was unlocked upon arrival. Truck 11 cleared the scene and returned to Station #1 and forwarded information onto the EL Fire Prevention for follow-up with the maintenance company with regards to resetting alarms.

September 10, 2015, 6:56 p.m. – East Lansing Truck 11 was dispatched to a vehicle fire on Wintercrest. Upon arrival they found a car parked in the lot with the hood open and the engine compartment on fire. Firefighters extinguished and requested EL Command to call for a tow truck to remove the vehicle. The vehicle was opened and no major damage noted to the interior. The owner stated they had taken the vehicle in for service for a gas line and tried to start the but it would not start. They opened the hood and noticed some tape on a tube that had come undone. They tried to start the vehicle again and the engine area ignited. Firefighters contacted the fire prevention personnel, cleaned up the fluid underneath the car and remained on the scene until the vehicle was hooked to the tow truck. They then cleared the scene and returned to Station #1.
