**Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

October 2, 2015, 5:57 p.m. – ELFD was dispatched to a location on Reniger for a fire. Firefighters arrived to find a 5 yard dumpster with the contents on fire. The fire was not impinging on any other structures and was contained to the dumpster. Firefighters pulled the front jump line and extinguished the fire. The only damage to the dumpster was a melted lid. Once the fire was out command was terminated and Truck 12 cleared.

October 2, 2015, 8:03 p.m. – ELFD reposed to Michigan and Harrison and arrived to find a CATA two piece bus with smoke coming from the rear engine compartment, no flames visible and all the occupants were out of the vehicle. Firefighters charged the front jump line, opened engine compartment to find a small fire around the exhaust pipe and they extinguished with very little water. It appeared that there was material wrapped around the exhaust that had burned. Contacted the on duty EL Fire Investigator and then cleared.

October 4, 2015, 11:39 p.m. – Truck 11 was dispatched to a fire alarm on MAC. While en route fire personnel were advised that there was no fire. Truck 11 responded non-emergency to find the occupants evacuating a 3 story residence. Firefighters investigated to find a resident had burned rice in a pot and the fire alarm sounding. Truck 11 reset the fire alarm panel to normal operation and then cleared the scene.

October 5, 2015, 10:38 p.m. – ELFD was called for a possible kitchen fire on Charles with one occupant unaccounted for. While en route they were updated that all of the occupants were accounted for and arrived to find nothing visible. Truck 11 was assigned to investigate and advise. All other units ordered to stage. Truck 11 personnel made entry and requested ventilation. Medic 11 was assigned to set up ventilation. A face to face with the Fire Captain confirmed that the fire was out and only ventilation was needed. Station 2 units were cleared and command was transferred to Truck 11.

## **Fires Reported in FireRMS page 2 of 2**

October 5, 2015, 10:55 p.m. - Called for a possible stove fire on Collingwood and arrived to find nothing visible. Truck 12 assigned to investigate, Medic 12 ordered to stage. Made contact with the occupant who stated that when they opened the oven door flames came out so they closed it. Firefighters investigated and reported that the fire was out and there was minimal smoke. Ventilation was requested and Medic 12 was assigned to complete the task. After a face to face with the Fire Lieutenant the fire was confirmed to be out, command was transferred to Truck 12 and then command cleared.

October 6, 2015, 11:37 p.m. - East Lansing Fire was dispatched to Wilson Road for burnt food in a microwave. Truck 12 was assigned to the call and responded with four personnel. Truck 12 arrived at a large six story dorm with nothing visible from the exterior. The truck crew entered the building and went to the room. The occupant stated that they had burned noodles in the microwave but no damage to it. Truck 12 cleared and returned to quarters.

October 8, 2015, 10:40 p.m. - Called to assist on a Lansing Fire on Sommerset Road and cancelled prior to arrival.

## **Training Reported in FireRMS**

October 7, 2015, 2-3 p.m. – Haz-Mat Incident Procedures - Both stations went to the CSO water plant on Kalamazoo Avenue. They toured the chemical storage building, discussed procedures for line gun operation and boom deployment.
