**Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

October 26, 2015, 9:24 a.m. - Dispatched to Elm Place for a possible structure fire. All responding rigs switched to Metro 1. Battalion 11 arrived at the scene to find a two story residential structure, no smoke or fire noted. Elm Place command was set up and all occupants were out of the house. Truck 12 was assigned to investigate and all other fire rigs were assigned Level 1 staging. Truck 12 advised no fire, all units could clear. Truck 11, Medic 11, and Medic 12 were cleared by Battalion 11. Command requested the fire inspector to the scene and then passed command to Truck 12.

October 27, 2015, 3:20 p.m. - East Lansing Fire was dispatched to smoldering mulch next to W. Circle. Truck 12 was assigned to the call and responded from the fuel pumps. Fire personnel arrived on the scene and found that someone had disposed of ashes next to the building in the mulch bed. There was a little smoldering and no flames noticed. Truck 12 crew used a bucket of water and shovel to extinguish the mulch and to salvage and overhaul the area. The truck then cleared the scene.

October 27, 2015, 11:30 p.m. - East Lansing Fire was dispatched to a trash can fire in the front of Owen Grad Hall. Truck 12 was assigned to the call and responded with four personnel. They arrived and found a trash can in front of Owen Hall. Michigan State University Police had used a fire extinguisher on the trash can. Firefighters used a bucket of water to make sure the fire was out and then they cleared and returned to quarters.

**Training Reported in FireRMS**

October 27, 2015, 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. – Alarm Systems – All on duty personnel had tours of several buildings on campus and were educated on the fire alarm panels and duct detector alarms.

October 28, 2015, 8:30-11:30 .m. – Pre-Incident Planning - All on duty personnel had building tours of Chemistry and the Simon Power Plant on MSU Campus. MSU EHS assisted building staff in showing fire personnel new procedures at the power plant. Also, they reviewed the chemistry building ventilation system.

October 28, 2015, 1:00-3:30 p.m. – Alarm Systems - MSU IPF showed all on duty personnel the fire alarm systems on campus. Discussed the locations and reset procedures. The buildings included were Spartan Stadium, Broad Museum, and Plant and Soil Sciences.

October 29, 2015, 8:30-11:30 a.m. - RAT training - All on duty went on a MSU/EHS tour of the MSU Power Plant and Chemistry Building.

October 29, 2015, 1:30-3:30 p.m. – Alarm Systems – All on duty personnel had review of the different alarm systems on campus. The buildings included Spartan Stadium, Broad Museum, and Plant and Soil Sciences.
