Fires Reported in FireRMS - page 1 of 3

December 5, 2015, 11:57 p.m. – ELFD T-11 was called for a couch fire on Linden and went en route emergent with 3 on board. They arrived to find a fully involved couch fire. Fire personnel extinguished and cleared.

December 5, 2015, 11:57 p.m. - ELFD was dispatched to Michigan Avenue for a couch fire. T-12 responded emergency and arrived on Louis to find a couch burning in the road with no exposures. The fire was extinguished with a bucket of water and the debris cleared from the road.

December 6, 2015, 12:03 a.m. - Called for a fire in the roadway at Victor and Woodmere. EL fire personnel arrived to find the same. They extinguished and cleared the roadway of debris.

December 6, 2015, 11:56 p.m. - T-11 was dispatched for a couch fire on Bailey. Fire personnel responded emergent while on the road and arrived to find a fully involved couch fire. They extinguished and cleared the scene.

December 6, 2015, 12:10 a.m. – EL T-11 was dispatched for a small couch fire at MAC and Elizabeth. They went en route while on the road and arrived to find a small couch on fire. Fire personnel extinguished and cleared the scene.

December 6, 2015, 12:03 a.m. - Called for a fire in the roadway on Louis. Responding fire personnel reported that this was probably the same fire as a previous run. They did a drive by and did not see anything burning so they continued to the next fire.

December 6, 2015, 12:17 a.m. - Dispatched for couch fire at Hillcrest and W. Grand River. T-11 went en route emergent from the road with 3 on board. Arrived on the scene to find a couch nearly burned out. Fire personnel extinguished, cleared and became available.

December 6, 2015, 12:13 p.m. - ELFD was dispatched to Elm and Center for a couch fire. T-12 responded emergency and arrived to find a couch burning in the road with no exposures. The fire was extinguished with water, debris cleared from the road and then T-12 cleared.

December 6, 2015, 12:48 a.m. - T-11 was called for a couch fire at Elizabeth and MAC and went en route emergent with 3 on board. Arrived to find a couch fire. They extinguished and cleared.

December 6, 2015, 12:51 a.m. - Called for a recliner on fire in the parking lot at Harrison and Elm Place. Fire units arrived to find the same, extinguished and cleared.

December 6, 2015, 1:11 a.m. - ELFD dispatched to Waters Edge for a dumpster fire. Truck 12 responded emergency and arrived to find a well involved dumpster fire with no exposures. The fire was extinguished with tank water and then T-12 cleared.

December 6, 2015, 1:16 a.m. – EL T-11 was called for a couch fire at Grand River and Durand. They responded emergent with 3 on board and arrived to find a chair on fire in the parking lot. They extinguished, cleared and became available.

December 6, 2015, 1:53 a.m. - Called for a mattress fire on Center and Oak. EL Fire units arrived to find the same in the middle of the road. They extinguished and cleared.

December 6, 2015, 2:46 a.m. - T-11 was dispatched for multiple items on fire in the road at Ann and Gunson. T-11 went en route to the scene and arrived to find a couch on fire in the road. They extinguished the fire and then they cleared from the scene.

December 8, 2015, 2:34 p.m. – EL Fire was called for mutual aid to Lansing Fire Department for a structure fire on Bassett Avenue. Upon arrival the EL Deputy Chief was assigned to the C/D Division. He provided fire conditions to command and then was cleared.

December 9, 2015, 10:54 a.m. - T-11 was dispatched to a multi-family dwelling on Haslett Road for a fire alarm. Firefighters investigated to find that the occupant was cooking on the stove top when the aluminum foil surrounding the burner caught fire. Fire personnel advised them that foil surrounding the burner was not advised. The occupant stated that the fire alarm did sound but no visible smoke in the apartment. T-11 gathered information and returned the fire alarm system to normal operation. They then cleared and returned to fire station 1.

December 9, 2015, 11:30 p.m. - T-11 was dispatched to a dumpster fire behind the 1300 block of East Grand River. T-11 arrived to find a dumpster fire with some surrounding refuse on fire as well. ELPD notified T-11 that they saw empty brass casings from a pistol outside of the dumpster. T-11 extinguished the fire without issue. The only damage was to the dumpster itself. The surrounding area had a lot of garbage. However, no noticeable extension outside of dumpster. T-11 cleared and returned to station #1.

December 10, 2015, 9:17 p.m. - Called to a sign on fire at Haslett and Hagadorn Road. Bystanders on the scene had the fire out but firefighters wet the area down with a hose reel. There was a Christmas tree placed on the side of the road too. As described by the bystanders, the fire was caused by the wind blowing over a wood sign on to a light. The only damage was a hole burned in the corner of the sign. T-11 cleared the scene.
