Fires Reported in FireRMS

January 18, 2016, 3:19 a.m. – EL Fire was toned out to the 1300 block of Abbot for a flow alarm reported by a fire monitoring service. Upon the fire department arrival nothing was visible from the exterior. Firefighters used a Knox key to gain access to the building. Once inside they found a light haze in the building and the sound of water flowing. They went around the corner to find a sprinkler head flowing over a small fire under the counter where the sprinkler could not extinguish. Firefighters extinguished with a small water fire extinguisher. They then called the EL Fire Investigator due to the conditions on the scene. Fire personnel also shut down the water to the sprinkler. Once the fire investigator and owner arrived on the scene they cleared fire personnel.
