Fires Reported in FireRMS

March 11, 2016, 2:04 p.m. - Called for a fire alarm activation on Woodbrook. B-11 responded, arrived, and established command. Upon arrival nothing showing and T-11 investigated, M-11 was RIC, M-12 and T-12 staged on Coolidge. Command evaluated the scene and upon doing a 360 walk around came across the occupant that had the fire. They stated they had a burn to their hand. M-12 was called up from staging to care for them. T-11 reported the cooking fire out and ventilation needed. The EL Fire Inspector was called and cleared T-12. T-11 ventilated and M-11 assisted with it. The EL Fire Inspector arrived on the scene, M-12 took care of the occupant and command was passed on to T-11.
