March 26, 2016, 1:12 a.m. – ELFD was called for a chair fire at River and Victor. Arrived and found the chair on fire in the road. The front 1 ¾” hose line was pulled and put out the fire. Cleaned up the street and cleared.

March 29, 2016, 7:18 p.m. - Dispatched to a grease fire at Williams Hall. Dispatch also advised flames were visible so switched over to TAC 1. T-12 was first to arrive, gave size, nothing visible and established command. Battalion arrived shortly after, assumed command while T-12 crew investigated. T-11 level 1 staged. T-12 reported no fire, fire was out and they could handle. Command cleared all other units and passed command to T-12.
