Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2

May 21, 2016, 9:19 p.m. – EL Fire was called to wood burning in a metal fire pit on Whitehills Drive. Upon arrival found that the occupant did not have a burn permit. Firefighters extinguished with their front jump line and advised them to call the fire prevention to see if they can get permit. Truck 11 then cleared the scene.

May 21, 2016, 10:15 p.m. – EL Fire was called to assist Lansing Fire Department on a structure fire on Ballard Street that had multiple calls on it; including explosion and exposure involvement. Lansing B-41 requested EL B-11 to respond and switch to Tac 1. Upon arrival EL B-11 was assigned to Charlie side supervisor. On the Charlie side found forceful smoke exiting an attic vent. The fire then developed in the eaves and the vent showed free burning. Lansing E-44 and T-44 were assigned to the Charlie side and they forced a second story exterior door and made a fire attack. The fire was knocked down and they overhauled the exterior siding/eaves and inside on the second floor and attic. The exterior ground lights were set up on the Charlie side and the safety officer informed EL B-11 to report to LFD B-41 at which time EL was cleared.

May 24, 2016, 1:33 p.m. – EL was called to assist LFD command with a structure fire on Cedar Street. EL B-11 responded, arrived, contacted LFD B-41 and was ordered to go to the C-side of the building and take command of it. EL B-11 arrived on the C side and did not see any fire or smoke. This was reported Lansing command. EL B-11 stayed at this location until the fire was out and then was cleared.

May 24, 2016, 3:29 p.m. – EL was dispatched to Grand River and Delta for a mulch fire with flames close to a tree and a vehicle. T-11 responded and arrived to find that the location was closer to Michigan and Delta. They established command and investigated. This was an approximately 6' x 12' area of wood chips smoldering with a small area of flames and moderate smoke. There was charred damage to the wood chips and at the base of the tree but was quickly extinguished with the rig front jump line. No damage noted to the vehicle. ELPD was on the scene and stated that an observer saw people smoking in the area earlier. No evidence noted at scene. The EL Fire Marshal and Inspector were out of town so an e-mail was sent to them about the situation. Advised dispatch of the above, terminated command and returned to quarters.

Fires Reported in FireRMS page 2 of 2

May 26, 2016, 1:15 p.m. – EL Battalion 11 and Truck 11 were called to assist LFD on a structure fire on Townsend. The responded and reported to Lansing command. EL B-11 was assigned to B-side command and EL T-11 to Division 5 for RIT. EL B-11 observed and assisted with CAN reports as requested. The fire was extinguished with no incidents on the Bravo side. Lansing command cleared EL personnel and they returned to station.

May 24, 2016, 8-11 a.m. – Trench Rescue – EL Fire Department station 2 personnel attended the trench rescue training in Delhi Township. They performed dewatering and installed a trench system. Metro training included Delhi Township and Lansing Fire Department.

May 25, 2016, no time reported – Trench Rescue – Station 1 personnel attended the trench training.

May 26, 2016, 8-11:30 a.m. – Trench Rescue – EL Truck 11 and Medic 12 personnel attended the metro trench training.
