Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 3

June 11, 2016, 3:59 a.m. – EL Fire was called to Meridian Township to assist on a structure fire on Graebear. EL B-11 responded, arrived and met with command. Operation was in defensive mode and EL T-11 set up the aerial on the Alpha-Delta corner and start flowing water. They had the fire knocked down in about 15 minutes. EL M-12 was called for rehab and M-11 was on another assignment. M-12 stood by until command said it was ok to shut T-11 down and cleared M-12. M-12 then assisted with T-11 on packing up. All units then cleared and returned to service.

June 11, 2016, 9:46 a.m. - Dispatched to a mulch fire on Albert. Arrived to find a passerby who met firefighters and direct them to a smoldering pile of mulch/yard waste. They stated they saw open flames prior to the fire department's arrival. Firefighters extinguished the mulch fire with a booster line and then pulled the pile apart with a shovel to thoroughly saturate it.

June 12, 2016, 11:22 a.m. - Called to Farm and Mt. Hope for a mulch fire. Arrived to find a small 10'x15' area of cedar mulch that was mostly smoldering with occasional flame up from the wind. Police were on the scene and had expended a couple of fire extinguishers with no affect. Firefighters used about 30 gallons of water to soak the area and put out the hot spots. The only damage to the property was about 2 bags of mulch and 2 small shrubs.

June 12, 2016, 2:26 p.m. - Called to smoldering mulch fire behind a location on Trowbridge near the dumpster. Arrived to find a small 5'x8' area with smoking mulch. Firefighters easily controlled it with 3-4 pails of water and a haligan tool. After cleaning up the small hot spots the fire department left to respond to another mulch fire call.

June 12, 2016, 2:52 p.m. - Called to Louis for another mulch fire. Arrived to find a small area 5'x5' that had a moderate amount of white smoke coming from smoldering mulch. Firefighters used one pail of water to extinguish all embers and hot spots before clearing.

June 12, 2016, 22:09 p.m. – EL B-11 was requested for mutual aid to MTFD for a reported structure fire on Hagadorn. B-11 arrived and found a large 3 story structure with nothing showing and Meridian E-91 on the scene. Meridian B-91 arrived and took command. EL B-11 performed a 360 walk around with nothing noted and the occupants reporting it was food on the stove. No flames or smoke visible with occupants evacuating. EL B-11 began scribing for Meridian's Command. EL M-11 was requested to evaluate an occupant from the apartment where the fire was. EL B-11 and T-11 were then cleared from scene.

June 14, 2016, 4:29 p.m. - Called for a brush fire on Chandler. Arrived to find that ELPD had found a small piece of trash in the parking lot smoldering and he put it out with his foot. T-11 cleared.

June 15, 2016, 11:49 p.m. - Dispatched to Whitehills Drive for a possible illegal burn outside a residence. Upon arrival found a small burn barrel already extinguished by one of the tenants. T-11 explained to the tenants they needed a permit for such use.

June 17, 2016, 5:53 p.m. - East Lansing Fire was dispatched to a possible structure fire on Orchard Street. A full box alarm was dispatched with a total of 11 personnel responding. B-11 arrived at a medium two story apartment building with nothing visible from the exterior. T-11 and M-11 were assigned to interior and Truck and M-12 on deck on the alpha side. T-11 reported that it was food on the stove and there no damage and T-12, M-12 and M-11 were cleared from the scene. Command turned over to T-11 and B-11 cleared.

June 19, 2016, 4:34 p.m. - T-11 was dispatched to Haslett Road for a small mulch fire. Upon arrival found a small amount of wood chips burning outside the apartments in the landscape area. T-11 extinguished the fire and then cleared.

June 19, 2016, 9:26 p.m. - B-11 was dispatched to a reported structure fire on Middlevale Road. Advised enroute it was an oven fire. Upon arrival B-11 took command and found light smoke coming from a 1st floor apartment. T-12 handled the suppression and ventilation. T-11 and M-11 were level one staging. B-11 cleared and transferred command to T-12.

June 21, 2016, 11:51 p.m. - B-11 was dispatched to a report of a structure fire on Michigan. Dispatch updated the fire crew's enroute that the occupants were attempting to extinguish the deck with a fire extinguisher. T-12 arrived and gave size-up of the fire on the deck. Station 1 units were advised to stage. B-11 arrived and assumed command. T-12 extinguished the fire and station 1 units cleared from the scene. The EL Fire Marshal was contacted via cell phone and was enroute to investigate. Command passed to T-12 and M-12 remained on the scene. T-12 to remain on the scene until fire prevention arrived. B-11 returned to Station 1.

Training Reported in FireRMS

June 14, 2016, 8:30-10:30 a.m. – Emergency Response Safety – 2 on duty personnel attended the AVI training at Otto Middle School. Practiced bandaging/wound care techniques and then participated in mock simulation in the school.

June 15, 2016, 8:30 – 10:30 a.m. – Other Rescue Training – 5 on duty personnel attended the AVI training.

June 21, 2016, 1:30-3:00 p.m. – Hose Training – All on duty personnel had practical high rise evolution per ELFD SOG. Training was held at East Holmes Hall. Training consisted of reviewing SOG, and explaining practical evolution of high rise standpipe fire attack.

June 22, 2016, 1:30-3:00 p.m. – Fire Ground Operations – All on duty personnel had High Rise SOG review and practical high rise evolution at East Holmes Hall.
