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**Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

July 8, 2016, 5:08 p.m. - East Lansing Fire was dispatched to a power line down causing the mast to be ripped off the house on Northlawn. Dispatch advised that the homeowner smelled something burning. Truck 11 was assigned to the call and responded with three personnel. Battalion 11 also responded due to the nature of the call. Truck 11 arrived, but able to give report due to heavy radio traffic. Battalion 11 arrived and switched all East Lansing units to Metro three channel. Smoke was seen from the roof vent of the home. Battalion 11 gave report and advised dispatch to request assist from Lansing and Meridian EL Fire Truck crew advised that they found fire in the attic of the home. A pre-connect hose was pulled from Truck 11 and the crew went interior to extinguish the fire. The Board of Water and Light requested due to house and attic being energized. The on-duty fire inspector contacted to respond. Board arrived and cut wires to home to de-energize the home. Truck 11 crew stated that the fire was under control once the power was cut. Lansing and Meridian were cleared from the scene. EL interior crew stated that wires were causing the problem. No other heat sources found with the Thermal Imaging Camera. Once the fire was under control Truck 12 cleared from scene. The on-duty fire inspector arrived and was given a briefing about the call. Truck 11 reported that the fire was out. Scene turned over to Fire Marshal and Battalion 11 cleared the scene.

July 9, 2016, 8:59 a.m. - Enroute to get fuel noticed yard waste burning behind a location on Coleman Road. Made contact with the resident and also the EL Fire Marshal to check to see if there was still a burning ban in place. The Fire Marshal confirmed it was so the fire was extinguished and advised the resident if they had any questions about the ban to contact the EL Fire Marshal.

July 9, 2016, 1:09 p.m. - Responded and arrived at Evergreen and Fern to find a lower electric line and trees burning. Contacted dispatch to put an emergency call into the BWL so they could at least cut the power. T-11 then put out the fire with a broken fog stream. BWL arrived within 10 minutes, cut the power and T-11 cleared.

July 9, 2016, 11:29 p.m. - Enroute back to the fire station noticed a fire pit burning on Snyder Road. Firefighters pulled over, explained the burning ban and extinguished the fire.

## **Fires Reported in FireRMS page 2 of 2**

July 10, 2016, 11:25 a.m. - Called for a power line arcing on Cowley. Upon arrival the power company was at a house where they were working on a line behind the house. The resident said they were pulling on the service line causing it to ark and spark at house under the siding and there was smoke puffing out around the siding. Firefighters pulled the siding and found aluminum coated Styrofoam burning and old wood lap boards on fire. Fire personnel put the fire out and pulled the siding off to expose the burnt spot. Firefighters found no extension so they put equipment away and cleared the scene.

July 12, 2016, 12:53 p.m. - T-12 was dispatched to smoke/fire in a trash can on Wilson Road. Dispatch updated T-12 enroute that this was a cigarette disposal container and that someone poured water in it and put the fire out. T-12 arrived to find a smoking container full of water. Fire personnel met with the caller and cleared shortly thereafter. T-12 returned to station 2.
