Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2

July 22, 2016, 2:08 p.m. – ELFD was called to Milford and Gr. River for a post on fire. Upon arrival and investigation firefighters found a decorative timber around a planting area that was on fire. It looked like someone had put a cigarette out and accidentally ignited the post that was deteriorated. Fire personnel poured water on post to put the fire out. It was still smoldering so they cut the post off below the char, cleared the scene and returned to the fire station.

July 27, 2016, 2:36 p.m. – ELFD was dispatched to a structure fire in a residence on Coolidge Road. Dispatch also reported that there was a handicapped resident in the upstairs that was unable to exit. Arrived, found no obvious fire and saw no smoke coming from a two story duplex. The occupant stated that the oven caught fire after they turned it on to use. They opened the oven door, saw flames closed the door, turned off the oven, and evacuated the duplex. Firefighters found no fire damage to the oven or surrounding cabinets. There was only obvious damage and deformity to the heating element in the oven. Contacted the EL Fire Marshal and advised him of details. He told fire personnel to unplug the oven, turn off the circuit to it in the fuse box and to advise the occupant to have the oven inspected by an electrician before using it again.

July 20, 2016, 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. – Water Rescue - All on duty personnel had classroom lecture from 10:00 to 11:00 a.m. The practical portion (boat operations) was on Lake Lansing from 1:00 to 5:30 p.m.

July 21, 2016, 10:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. – Water Rescue - Water rescue lecture at fire station 1 with practical training at Lake Lansing.

July 26, 2016, 1:30-4:00 p.m. – Aerial Ladder Operations - Station 1 practiced aerial ladder operation. Practiced placing the ladder onto the station in several different locations.

July 26, 2016, 1:30-4:30 p.m. – Standard Hydrant Hook-up Evolutions – no further description.
