**Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

September 5, 2016, 7:54 p.m. - Called for dumpster fire on Middlevale. Firefighters arrived and found light smoke but no fire. Found someone had put cooking charcoal in the dumpster. A hose line was pulled and put the fire out. T-12 then cleared.

September 7, 2016, 7:35 p.m. - T-12 was dispatched to a fire alarm on Garden City Road. T-12 arrived to find a 4 story apartment building with nothing showing and no one had evacuated. T-12 investigated and found a fire alarm panel showing activation in a room. Firefighters investigated to find the occupant had cooked pancakes and burned them. The apartment had light smoke and fire personnel ventilated it. They then reset fire alarm to normal operation and then cleared.

September 14, 2016 10:03 p.m. – ELFD was called for a fire alarm on Garden City Road. Arrived and advised it was burnt food in a pan but no fire. Firefighters cleared the room of smoke and then reset the alarm to normal.

September 14, 2016, 10:10 p.m. - Called for an alarm sounding on Garden City Road. T-12 was on the scene of a separate incident at a nearby fire alarm. The driver of T-12 walked to the 2nd alarm to investigate and found to be food on the stove. There was very light smoke that had tripped a single alarm head. Natural ventilation was used to remove the smoke and then the alarm was reset to normal.

September 6, 2016, 1:30-4:00 p.m. – Forcible Entry – All on duty personnel watched a video on different techniques for forcing doors. Swinging in/out metal doors, doors with bars and metal restrictors. They followed up with hands on utilizing "Simulation Door" with replaceable stops.

September 8, 2016, 9:30-11:30 p.m. - Forcible Entry – All on duty personnel watched a video on different techniques for forcing doors. Swinging in/out metal doors, doors with bars and metal restrictors. They followed up with hands on utilizing "Simulation Door" with replaceable stops.

September 11, 2016, 4:30 5:30 p.m. – Community – 3 on duty personnel stood by with a fire truck at a community picnic at the Shaw Park on Northlawn. They demonstrated the truck to the kids, provided education and stickers.
