**Fires Reported in FireRMS page 1 of 2**

October 6, 2016, 8:32 a.m. - T-12 responded to a smoking vehicle on Grand River. Upon arrival, the vehicle was upright with hood open. The owner stated he was alerted to his vehicle smoking and then opened the hood and observed visible flames from the wires behind the driver side headlight. He and the police used an extinguisher to put out the fire. The fire department saw no fire at the time they arrived. Firefighters advised the owner to have the vehicle towed and they would need to disconnect the battery. The owner wanted to drive the vehicle to a dealer, but was advised that if the fire re-kindled, the damage may become severe. He agreed to have it towed.

October 8, 2016, 3:04 p.m. - Called for a wood chip fire on Trowbridge and Palmer Road. Arrival to find a 10 x 10 ft. woodchip fire. Deployed a garden hose and put it out. T-12 then cleared.

October 9, 2016, 12:16 a.m. – EL Truck 12 was called for charcoal burning at the top of the stairway at the parking ramp on Harrison Road. Arrived to find nothing showing. MSUPD reported charcoal at the top of the stairs and firefighters found a bag of charcoal at the top of the 4<sup>th</sup> floor burning. They put it out with a water extinguisher and then cleared.

October 10, 2016, 4:31 p.m. - Called to Shaw Lane for a possible trash bin smoking. Arrived to find MSU Police searching for any sign of fire, but unable to locate. Dispatch informed us it was near a parking meter. Firefighters were then able to locate a trash receptacle that had a quarter size piece of trash in it that had previously burned out. No current fire so the fire department cleared.

October 13, 2016, 2:43 p.m. - Dispatched to assist Lansing Fire Department on a possible structure fire in a school on Stoneleigh Dr. Ordered by LFD Battalion to stage on Stoneleigh. EL staged upon arrival and then was cleared by LFD Battalion.

October 11, 2016, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. – Rescue Training – 4 EL FF participated in the Metro Tower Rescue training with State of Michigan radio tower steeplejacks. One man pick offs and three man pick off with use of tracking line.
