**Fires Reported in FireRMS**

December 16, 2016, 9:03 a.m. – ELFD was called to Swine Research on Power Line Drive. Dispatch advised that there was a fire in the vent. However, they think it had been extinguished and people were evacuating the building. Upon arrival by fire department units there was no immediate fire or smoke showing. M-12 was to meet up with T-12 and investigate. T-11 and M-11 to stage on College Rd. T-12 entered the building and a short time later removed an approximately 10' x 10' sheet of laminated plywood which had been charred. They also removed two 10' sections of rolled insulation with some showing charring and part of it still smoldering. MSU Fire Prevention arrived to investigate and fire units cleared the scene.

December 16, 2016, 7:55 p.m. – ELFD T-12 and M-12 were dispatched to assist Meridian Township Fire Department on White Owl Way for a possible chimney fire. EL B-11 placed self on call. While enroute heavy snow and slippery roads slowed down travel. Also while en route B-11 was advised that there was no fire but to continue non emergent and to stage. B-11 continued and upon arrival on the scene MTFD command cleared all ELFD rigs.
