Fires Reported in FireRMS – page 1 of 2

January 11, 2017, 7:29 p.m. – ELFD T-12 was dispatched an apartment complex on Glemoor for smoke coming from an electrical outlet. They arrived to find a medium sized two story apartment building with nothing showing. They investigated to find occupants outside stating smoke was coming from an electrical outlet. Upon entering the structure they noted moderate amount of smoke coming from the second floor. T-12 contacted dispatch and requested a full alarm from East Lansing Fire. They then contacted B-11 and suggested for all fire units to level-1 stage. Fire personnel noted smoke and fire within a wall behind an electrical outlet in the laundry room. They attempted to unplug the appliance and the whole electrical outlet came with the cord. They moved the washer and dryer out of the way and began opening the wall and found charred structural 2x4 with smoldering insulation in the area. They extinguished what was exposed and requested another unit to assist with pulling the ceiling. T-12 crew shut off the power to the building and it was also disconnected via the circuit breakers in the basement. Ventilation was then requested and cleared the smoke from the structure. Command was notified that the fire was out and fire personnel would continue to overhaul area and extinguish any hot spots utilizing Thermal Imaging Camera. The EL Fire Marshal was contacted by Command and was enroute. All other units were cleared and T-12 assumed command remained on the scene until the fire marshal arrived. DTN management and maintenance had also arrived and they were working with the fire marshal for a plan to isolate the damage and begin repairs. T-12 cleared the scene and terminated command.

January 10, 2017, 7:55-8:55 a.m. – Other Equipment Training – A representative from a company performed a demonstration on a thermal imaging camera.

January 10, 2017, 1:30-3:30 p.m. – Inspecting/Care/Maintaining SCBA – All on duty fire personnel performed SCBA proficiency tests. They also performed room search with entanglement, MAYDAY, and bottle change out while on air.

January 12, 2017, 1:30-3:30 p.m. – Donning/Wearing/Using SCBA – All on duty fire personnel performed SCBA competencies.
