**Fires Reported in FireRMS – page 1 of 2**

January 13, 2017, 11:07 p.m. - Dispatched to a car fire. Upon arrival found a parked car with light smoke coming from the engine compartment. Firefighters disconnected the battery and applied water to a smoking electrical wire. They then cleared with dispatch.

January 14, 2017, 11:05 p.m. - T-11 responded for a report of an illegal burn behind a location on Ann St. The police department arrived first and checked the immediate area finding nothing. Fire personnel made contact with them and eventually the callers came outside and pointed us in the direction of a location on Charles. There firefighters found the remains of a burned Christmas tree with a melted bottle of rubbing alcohol beside it. The fire had been extinguished and was no longer a hazard. The fire department made contact with the residents and advised them to make better decisions going forward. They were also advised them that the fire prevention division would be notified and that they may see the fire marshal in the next few days.

January 19, 2017, 10:57 a.m. – EL Fire was dispatched to mutual aid to Meridian Township for a possible structure fire on Briarwick Drive. EL Truck 11 arrived to find a small duplex with nothing showing from the exterior. EL Truck 11 was the first arriving fire apparatus. The resident reported there was black smoke coming from vents in the house, and when they made their way to the basement, they saw fire and smoke coming from the furnace. Resident stated they were the only person home, and there were cats on the 2nd floor. Meridian Command requested Truck 11 to make entry into structure. Upon entering they found moderate black smoke present on the first floor. They made their way into first floor and the primary search was clear. They then proceeded to the basement where they found light smoke and evidence of fire in furnace. The Thermal Imaging Camera showed heat inside of the furnace vent stack but no fire. EL Firefighters turned off the gas to the furnace and switched the breaker off. They then made their way to the 2nd floor and found moderate smoke and did a primary search which was clear. They opened windows on the 2nd and 1st floors to clear the smoke. Truck 11 personnel then exited the structure for a face to face with Meridian Command and EL B11. Once their hose was back on the truck and equipment secured they were cleared by Command.

## **Fires Reported in FireRMS – page 2 of 2**

January 19, 2017 9:48 p.m. - Dispatched to East Akers Hall for a fire alarm. EL T-12 was en route and arrived to find a 6 story dormitory with nothing showing from the exterior. Truck 12 investigated and the fire alarm panel showed a smoke alarm in a room on the 6<sup>th</sup> floor. Firefighters made contact with occupants who had made Macaroni and Cheese and forgot to add water. There was no damage to the room, but the inside of the microwave was slightly blackened. The fire alarm panel was reset to normal by the MSU trouble truck and then EL Truck 12 cleared.
