Fires Reported in FireRMS

January 23, 2017, 12:23 p.m. - T-12 was dispatched to fire alarm on Chestnut Road. They arrived to find a large 6 story dorm with nothing showing. Firefighters investigated to find alarm sounding and the fire panel indicating which room. Staff stated no fire, the occupant was cooking in the microwave and T-12 found burned food in the microwave. The occupant had also removed smoke head from ceiling and was told by fire personnel not to touch smoke heads and replaced. T-12 reset the fire alarm panel to normal operation. The also noted that the building panel at the door was not working and IPF was notified.

January 23, 2017, 8:18 p.m. - Dispatched to Armstrong Hall for a fire alarm. Enroute emergent from station 2 with three on aboard Truck 12. They arrived to find a large, 4 story dormitory, nothing showing from the exterior. Firefighters investigated and found that the fire panel showed the smoke alarm sounding a room. Upon exiting the elevator there was an odor of burnt food present. The occupant stated that they burnt some breadsticks in the microwave. There was no smoke, fire or damage to the microwave noted. The panel was reset to normal and Truck 12 cleared and was available.

January 26, 2017, 1:30-3:00 p.m. – Patient Assessments – All on duty personnel participated in the EMS physical assessment of medical and trauma patients with the application of a traction splint.
