Fires Reported in FireRMS

February, 13, 2017, 4:15 a.m. – The East Lansing Fire was dispatched to a location on West Grand River for the side of a home that was on fire. The occupants had extinguished the fire and wanted the fire department to check it out. Upon arrival found the exterior of the house had moderate charring extending to the second floor with no extension to the interior of the structure. One of the first floor windows was broken from a brick being thrown through it from the exterior. There was a strong smell of gasoline also present and noted there was no smoldering of the siding, no heat signature with TIC, and all the water on the ground was frozen prior to Truck 12 arriving. The EL Fire Marshal and Battalion Chief were both contacted and advised of the situation. ELPD stayed on scene to secure it.

February 13, 2017, 5:57 p.m. – Dispatched to Saginaw and Hagadorn for a small car on fire. Upon arrival found a fire in the engine compartment, fire coming out from under the hood and the front tires were also on fire. Parked Truck 11 40 feet up wind of the rear of the vehicle and pulled the front booster line and started to extinguish the fire. Firefighters turned off the ignition and put the transmission in park. They used a halogen tool to gain access to engine the compartment due to the latch did not work. Firefighters extinguished the fire with foam, stayed to block the road for the tow truck and then cleared the scene when the tow truck cleared.
