Fires Reported in FireRMS – page 1 of 2

March 4, 2017, 3:50 p.m. - Dispatched for mutual aid to Lansing Fire on a structure fire on Shiawassee Street. Truck 11 responded emergent with 4 personnel on aboard. They were advised to stage at MLK and Shiawassee. They arrived and reported to Lansing Command. They were ordered to come to scene and go on deck. Once on deck they were ordered to establish a supply line from Engine 41 to Truck 41. When that task was completed, EL Truck 11 assigned to help with pulling ceilings on the 2nd floor. Once they completed the overhaul they advised command of the need to recycle. After that they were cleared.

March 8, 2017, 11:30 p.m. - East Lansing Fire dispatched to a possible structure fire on Glenhaven. A full box alarm for the City was dispatched with a total of 13 personnel responding. Truck 11 arrived on the scene and reported a tri-level home with nothing visible from the roadway and went to investigate. Battalion 11 arrived and assumed Glenhaven Command. Truck 11 reported a small amount of fire was in the interior on the lower level. They were going to force entry and use a water can to extinguish the fire. Medic 11 was assigned to go on deck on the alpha side. Truck 12 was assigned to stage at the hydrant, and Medic 12 was assigned to report to on deck on the alpha side with Medic 11 crew. Truck 11 crew forced the door and extinguished the fire in the home. This home was one house to the south from where a primary line was down and burning on the ground earlier in the day. Firefighters reported that Station 1 crews could handle. Truck and Medic 12 cleared by command. Truck 11 requested a positive pressure fan for ventilation. Medic 11 crew set up fan for the Truck Company. Truck 11 officer briefed Command in a face to face. The family room in the lower level had the main breaker that was melted and damaged. The carpet was burning out from an area in front of the breaker panel. Fire personnel stated that area had been checked with thermal imager and no extension was found. Dispatched was advised that EL Fire Prevention needed to call the Command cell phone. The Fire Marshal called and was briefed on the incident. The decision was made that he was not going to come in and would follow up in the morning. Command asked dispatch for a board up crew for the front door and the Board of Water and Light pulled the meter so the house didn't become energized again. Battalion 11 cleared and transferred command to Truck 11.
