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**Fires Reported in FireRMS – page 1 of 2**

April 3, 2017, 9:05 a.m. – EL Fire was called to Shaw Lane for a fire alarm. Upon arrival and investigation found that there had been a trash can fire inside the building that was put out by residents prior to the fire department arriving. Firefighters ventilated the building and then cleared the scene.

April 4, 2017, 1:03 p.m. – EL Fire was dispatched to a possible kitchen fire. Enroute dispatch stated no fire. B11 arrived and confirmed. The fire department arrived and investigated. The occupant was cooking with oil that caught fire. They turned the burner off and removed the pan. No damage to anything near the pan. Also, no smoke stains on ceiling or nearby cabinets. Fire personnel checked the surrounding surface areas with TIC and found no high heat areas. Advised the occupant to use a lid to smother the pan fire if this happens again.

April 6, 2017, 4:50 p.m. – East Lansing Fire was called for a car fire on E. Grand River. Firefighters arrived and found a van sitting in the parking lot, with no exposures and the fire coming from the passenger rear corner of the van. Firefighters pulled a 1 ¾” line and put fire out using approximately 100 gallons of water. They summoned the fire prevention bureau and upon their arrival informed them of the incident. The fire inspector took control of the scene and Truck 12 personnel then cleared.

April 7, 2017, 4:02 p.m. – ELFD was requested for mutual aid by Meridian Township Fire Department for a structure fire on Jolly Road. Meridian requested a truck, engine, and medic. East Lansing T-12, T-11, M-12, and B11 responded to the request. When East Lansing B11 arrived, they found MTFD and T-12 out with a pole barn fire and the fire was nearly out. T12 fed MTFD engine tank water until a tanker arrived. EL B-11 reported to Meridian command and they stated when T-12 was out of water all ELFD units could clear.

April 9, 2017, 10:28 a.m. – ELFD was called for possible illegal burn near Coolidge and Wolf Ct. Upon arrival the occupant was burning dimensional lumber in an old bath tub that had no lid and no burning permit. The fire department advised they needed a permit and explained that they could not burn these types of materials or leaves. Firefighters put the fire out and cleared the scene.

April 11, 2017, 11:27 p.m. – ELFD T-12 was dispatched to fire alarm on Garden City Road. They arrived to find a large 4 story apartment building to find nothing showing. The occupant met fire personnel at the door and they stated they were cooking rice and the steam set the detector off. T-12 investigated to find smoke head detected with nothing unusual noted. The system was reset to normal operation and then T-12 cleared and returned to station 2.

April 4, 5 and 6, 2017, 1:30-2:30 p.m. – RAT Team/Field Decontamination Procedures – All on duty personnel had Level a Dress out and decontamination procedures with MSU EHS.

April 11, 2017, a.m. – Vehicle Extrication – 3 on duty personnel went to Lansing Fire Department for a CATA/Hybrid bus class.

April 11 and 13, 2017, 1:30 – 2:30 p.m. – Pre-Incident Planning/Emergency Response Safety – All on duty personnel had their quarterly tour of the MSU FRIB with special attention to the fire alarm system.
