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**Fires Reported in FireRMS**

May 6, 2017, 12:22 AM- T-12 was dispatched to couch fire in roadway in the middle of intersection with ELPD in area.

May 6, 2017, 12:23 AM Couch fire in road. Extinguished with front jump line. Moved debris out of road. T11 cleared.

May 7, 2017, 1:03 AM- Couch fire extinguished by resident. T11 crew put more water on entire couch then moved it into driveway. Fire out. T11cleared.

May 13, 2017, 1:14 AM- dispatched for a structure fire at an apt. complex. Fire was knocked down at this point and looking for extension and getting all clears. M-12 on scene and called to evaluate one patient. Assisted in getting cat and dog to M-12, returning to assist Command. Monitored T-11 tasks. Command requested FM from ELFD. Dispatch to contact him per radio communication. I attempted to call FM to provide info on current situation. Command later advised no further needs. Clarified that M-12 was no longer needed for standby and confirmed. Advised dispatch all ELFD rigs cleared per command, returning to quarters and back on fire main

May 13, 2017, 6:23- Dispatched to a fire in the mulch behind the restaurant. Arrived and found smoldering mulch, about 3 ft square area. Restaurant staff stated there were flames reported by driver. Staff put two buckets of water on mulch prior to our arrival. We saturated the mulch with foam and water and completely extinguished the fire.

May 15, 2017, 5:51 PM- T-11 dispatched for car fire. Vehicle upright with severe damage to front of vehicle from MVA prior to fire. Fire knock down and K-12 used to access engine compartment by cutting triangle in hood around hood latch. Fire extinguished at 1812 hrs. With 250 gallons of water used. Dispatched contacted T-11 via radio stating male needing oval for neck pain near ELPD. FF assessed patient and notified Lt. Newman requesting ambulance for Trans. T-11 contacted dispatch via radio requesting ambulance. M-411 responded, FF Trans patient care and report to M-411. M-411 Tran's pt to ER.

May 16, 2017. 11:07AM-Dispatched to a trash can smoking. Arrived and found no obvious smoke or fire. Checked both trash cans in two locations at the NW intersection. Found burnt items in one of the trash cans. Used jump line to soak the trash. No damage to trash can.

May 16, 2017, 4:24- On the road, dispatched to a mulch fire. Arrived to find smoldering mulch where bystanders stomped out flames. We soaked the mulch with water and foam to completely extinguish fire.

May 17, 2017, 1:12- Called to MSU FCU on Mt Hope for dumpster fire. Arrived at the theater scene production barn, behind MSU FCU and found a large gondola full of wood scraps and saw dust, fully involved. After establishing command, we pulled front jump line and used 1 3/4" hose to spray the building next to the fire. The structure was not overly hot, and we proceeded to extinguish contents inside the dumpster. FF Kelly was on the nozzle as I directed her and used NY tool to expose hidden fires. We used about 200 gal of water to knock fire out, but another 500 to finish overhaul. The "owner" arrived, and moved the gondola to a safer location away from building, and we continued to mop up. Fire Marshal and FF arrived on scene and agreed that we could leave remaining burnt scraps in it, and clear, as no signs of active fire remained. Cleared just prior to taking a PI on 127

May 18, 2017, 2:36- B-11 placed self on call after hearing East Town Command request a Battalion. B-11 en route emergent to 2500 Showtime Dr for multiple mulch fires. Placed on Ingham Tac 1. Arrived on scene and was instructed to report with E-48 to the front of the Apple Store and monitor the mulch fires there. Once extinguished advised to have E-48 pack up and report back to the Cinema. B-11 met up with Command. Released. Return to quarters and back on fire main.

May 18, 2017, 3:40- Called for wood chip fire. Arrival with landscape area smoking. 10x10 area .No flame only smoke. Jump line pulled and 50 gal water to the smoking woodchips. T 12 cleared.

May 26, 2017, 11:41- T-12 was dispatched to fire alarm at Natural Resources. T-12 at nothing showing in large 4 story structure. T-12 found alarm panel sounding with smoke head activated in room 410. T-12 investigated to find that someone burned a sandwich cooking. T-12 reset fire alarm system to normal operation and then cleared the scene.

May 27, 2017, 8:59- East Lansing Fire dispatched to assist Meridian Township on a possible apartment fire. Truck, Medic, and Battalion 11 were assigned to the call and responded with a total of six personnel. Battalion 11 arrived on scene and found Meridian units on scene starting to investigate the call. Truck and Medic 11 arrived and level one staged. Command had Truck and Medic 11 assist with overhaul of a small fire in the building. Once overhaul completed, all East Lansing Units cleared and returned to quarters.

June 26, 2017, 8:27- Called for car fire, Arrival and found a MSU service truck on fire. No exposures. Pulled 1 3/4 line and put it out without incident. Truck a total loss. MSU Fire Marshal on site for investigation. T 12 cleared.

June 27, 2017, 11:10- East Lansing Fire dispatched to assist Meridian Township on a possible apartment fire. Truck, Medic, and Battalion 11 were assigned to the call and responded with a total of six personnel. Battalion 11 arrived on scene and found Meridian units on scene starting to investigate the call. Truck and Medic 11 arrived and level one staged. Command had Truck and Medic 11 assist with overhaul of a small fire in the building. Once overhaul completed, all East Lansing Units cleared and returned to quarters.

July 5, 2017, 7:34- Called to a brush fire, Found PD in front of with a 55 gallon plastic barrel used for trash, completely melted down and on fire. PD updated they could extinguish, but his dry chemical extinguisher was empty, and fire was growing as we spotted up to deploy the garden hose...

After about 10 minutes of overhaul and 15 gallons of water, we cleared

July 13, 2017, 4:23- East Lansing Fire dispatched to a possible structure fire at 1350 Lake Lansing in the north district of the City of East Lansing at 0425 hours. A full box alarm was dispatched to the call. Truck 11 arrived on scene and investigated. Battalion 11 arrived and assumed command. Truck 111 assigned water supply and staged at hydrant. Truck 11 reported that it was a forklift that was on fire and that the fire was out. Truck 11 remained on scene, all other units cleared by command. Battalion cleared and returned to quarters.

## Training Reported in FireRMS

May 2 & 4, 2017, 2 hours- deployment of attack line in several different configurations including triple layer load and Cleveland load.

May 16.2017, 2 hours - Set up foam educator and flowed class B foam. Operated hoseline. Hooked to hydrant.

May 23, 2017, 10 hours. 30 minutes- Machine Rescue for MITF1.

May 25, 2017, 2 hours- Tours of sites on MSU campus. Highlighted hazard areas for chemical storage. Agronomy, Dairy, Digester, Horticulture, EHS

May 25, 2017. 1 hour -Toured MSU FRIB to locate "sniffer" detectors and learn how to reset them, along with the fire alarm system.

May 31, 2017, 3 Hours- Metro Trench Training at EL DPW. Viewed Vacuum truck, and ran a straight trench simulation with victim in trench. Placed panels, shoring, and extricated pt safely. LFD, Delhi FD, ELFD participated.

June 8, 2017, 30 minutes- Air trailer hitching procedures and boat hitching/motor procedures.

June 15, 2017, 2 hours- FF led class on confined space rescue, single company. Set up entry using the confined space bag on the truck. Practiced using the ladder tip anchor for overhead anchor.

June 20, 2017, 2 hours- ELFD and EHS toured Phillips/ Snyder and Hubbard Halls with emphasis on fire alarm panels, floor arrangement, Mech. room locations and basic familiarity of the structures.

June 27, 2017, 2 hours- Classroom Extrication techniques

July 6, 2017, 2 hours- Lt provided video of several RIT operations. Table top discussion of RIT operations. FF did a demonstration of a mechanical advantage to rescue a firefighter out of a window.

July 12, 2017, 1 hour- PL Customs presented an ambulance demonstration.

July 12, 2017, 2 hours, 30 minutes-Lt and FF provided RIT training to station 1 crews.

Performed Denver Drill, Nance Drill, Widow Maker Drill, downed firefighter rescue. Discussion on RIT procedures.
