Fires Reported in FireRMS

January 9, 2018, 8:35 PM- dispatched to a structure fire. T-12 arrived just after B-11. ELPD reporting the fire is out. T-12 ordered to investigate the fire. T-12 made our way to rear of structure with nothing showing. T-12 was led to apartment #6 on 3rd floor and let in by occupants. Occupant states she was smoking about an hour ago and she discarded her cigarette into a plastic trash basket on the deck and covered trash with a towel. She heard her smoke detector activate approx. an hour later and dismissed it as her roommates cooking. She investigated the alarm after some time to find that the balcony was on fire and that the window glass had shattered. Her and her roommate extinguished most of the fire with buckets or bowls of water. T-12 found the balcony on the third floor had some shattered glass and some charred exterior wood siding. M-12 reported seeing some smoke coming from the B/C eaves of the structure. T-12 began overhauling the immediate fire area to uncover fire within the ceiling joists. T-12 requested Command have T-11 ladder the structure and give a roof report. T-12 also requested that M-12 stretch a line to the 3rd floor. T-12 crew extinguished most of the fire within the ceiling with a water can and began to overhaul the interior and exterior of the structure to search void spaces. T-11 assisted for a brief period of time. Command called Fire Prevention and shortly thereafter cleared T-11. T-12 remained and Command was transferred to T-12 after B-11 cleared the scene. Occupant Williams was interviewed and admitted to leaving a discarded cigarette in a plastic trash bin on the balcony outside of the apartment. T-12 awaited FM Carter's arrival and then briefed him of the situation. T-12 allowed occupants to grab some personal items while attended. No occupants were allowed in the fire origin area. T-12 also tried to contact management and emergency maintenance without success. T-12 left a message. T-12 then terminated Command and returned to Station.

January 12, 2018, 6:43PM- T-12 was dispatched to a fire alarm. T-12 atf large 4 story apartment with nothing showing and occupants evacuated. T-12 investigated to find occupant who met us at the door. She states she was cooking with her oven. Strong smell of burned food and smoke throughout hallway. T-12 found apartment full of smoke and oven still hot. Occupant was baking with oven and burned residual food in base of oven was smoking heavily. T-12 gathered info. and began ventilating the hallway and apartment. T-12 reset the fire alarm system and returned to Station.
