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**Fires Reported in FireRMS**

**February 2, 2018, 7:26 AM-** T-12 was dispatched to a fire alarm at E Holden Hall. T-12 atf large 6 story with nothing showing. T-12 investigated to find fire panel showing room #421 smoke head activated. T-12 investigated to find that occupant's cell phone fell from bunk and exploded onto floor catching on fire. No actual fire upon arrival. Cell phone had extinguished by the time we arrived. T-12 ventilated the floor and room involved. T-12 then reset the fire alarm panel and cleared the scene.

**February 7, 2018, 8:45 PM-** Dispatched to report of a dryer smoking. Arrived and occupant met us at the door and stated her clothes dryer was smoking. She showed us to third story condo. We entered the two level condo, and found the stackable washer/dryer unit in a closet just big enough to house the unit. The unit had flames coming around the closed washer lid. Used a water can to extinguish the flames. Opened the lid and found more flames, extinguished with water can. Had FF go to second level and turn off breaker to unit. He stated it was tripped but still turned it to off position. FF and I removed the closet door and pulled the unit out of the closet. There was a small fire in the carpet padding on the floor. Extinguished with water can. TIC showed floor to be 110F. This was about a 6 inch diameter of burn mark. No burn marks on surrounding floor, walls, or ceiling. Walls and ceiling about 90F with TIC. Upstairs was full of smoke, almost to no visibility. Used positive pressure fan to ventilate entire condo. Opened patio doors and windows as needed.

No significant heat found with TIC in any floors, walls, or ceilings in the upstairs. Specifically in the closet directly over the washer/dryer closet on the first floor. This upstairs closet is the mechanical room where the breaker box is located.

Checked the washer/dryer plug. Both the wall plug and the unit plug showed no signs of fire. Items of clothing in the upper dryer were melted. These were disposed of with a metal pail and put in the onsite dumpster. There was melted plastic parts inside the dryer. Items in the

washer were left at the owner's request. They were damaged but she wanted to look through them. Advised her to put them in the dumpster when she was finished.

Contacted Fire Inspector Stover. Advised him of the situation. He stated fire prevention would investigate during normal business hours. Advised owner. FI and I both agreed to move the unit outside the building. Property manager arrived and stated he would have a crew move the unit outside and place it by the dumpster so fire prevention could see it at a later time.
