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### Fires Reported in FireRMS

**March 18, 2018, 2:00 PM-** T11 on the road, dispatched to a possible structure fire at restaurant. Reported heavy smoke coming from the entry door. Enroute, B11 had us switch to TAC 1. Arrived and found nothing visible. Saw several people standing on South side of building, but saw no smoke and interior of restaurant was clear. Walked over and spoke with manager who pointed out a small fire in one bush, West of the door on the South entrance. Fire had burned into the mulch also. Staff had used dry chemical fire extinguisher to smother the fire. We used about 100 gallons of tank water to saturate the surrounding bushes and mulch until no smoldering was noticed. It was reported to me and ELPD of a man, who was banned from the restaurant, who was seen just before the fire was found. He was noticed outside the South entrance. No witnesses were found and the manager stated there was no security camera pointed to this area. The man was not present when the fire dept was on scene. After returning to the station, I notified on call FI Stover by phone. The manager did not know if the owner would be turning in an insurance claim for the damage to the bush.

**March 19, 2018, 12: 21 PM-** Trash container was on fire. Resident put it out with extinguisher. T11 crew pulled it to the curb and filled with water. Advised resident to call city and get new container. T11 cleared.

**March 20, 2018, 12: 22 PM-** T-11 was dispatched for brush fire at disp loc. T-11 responded emergent with three on board from St 1. T-11 found active brush fire North of Abbot Rd. T-11 advanced the hose reel from the front of T-11 in full PPE and extinguished a brush fire that covered an area approximately 75 feet by 100 feet. The area burned involved cattails and small dead trees. T-11 layed 2 lengths of 5" for water supply. T-11 cleared and returned to St 1.

**March 15, 2018, 2 Hours-** Command presentation and discussion of Rapid Intervention Team draft for Metro fire departments.

**March 15, 2018, 1.5 Hours-** FF Sterling provided lecture on managing patient on ventilators.

**March 21, 2018, 2 hour-** Metro fire department instructors presented phase 2 of the Metro RIT training. Review of Pack Tracker, entanglement and small opening exit, RIT stack with victims.
