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**Fires Reported in FireRMS**

**July 27, 2018, 6:08 PM-** Called for a fire alarm. Arrival and panel showing room 352. Went to the room and looked in the window and something small on the desk burning. No one in the room and had to break window to gain access. Opened the door and covered the burning 9 volt lantern batteries with a small metal trash can. Vented the room. Fire out, smoke cleared. Turned over to MSU DPS. T 12 cleared.

**August 1, 2018, 5:33 PM-** Dispatched for mutual aid into Meridian Twp. for a structure fire on Grand River Ave. Enroute, switched to ING TAC channel, contacted Meridian command for assignment on our arrival. Arrived to find a small one story stand along business with smoke showing. Met up with MTFD command and was instructed to have my crews force the "C" side door towards the rear of the business. T-11 was given forcible entry assignment, while Meridian interior crews were working to extinguish the fire. M-11 crew paired up with T-11, a second line was pulled and ELFD crews entered thru forced door to assist in extinguishment. Fire was extinguished, and overhaul operations were performed by same crew. Fire reported out, and ELFD personnel exited structure, all personnel accounted for. Face to face with Meridian command was done, and after some time for building to clear out, T-11 / M-11 crew re-entered with TIC, to perform final salvage and overhaul operations. I met with command, and it was determined that on scene MTFD crews could handle, ELFD units returned back to service. Cleared scene, returned back to Main.
