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### Fires Reported in FireRMS

**August 7, 2018, 7:40 PM-** T-12 was dispatched to a fire alarm at Clinical Center. T-12 at large 2 story structure with nothing showing. T-12 found alarm panel in normal operation. T-12 tried to make access and was unable due to locked doors. T-12 made contact with IPF and they stated no fire unintentional smoke head activation. They reset the system prior to our arrival. T-12 told them next time to leave system in alarm until ELFD confirms issue. T-12 cleared. T-12 called back to Clinical Center after MSU PD still on scene reporting the smell of something burning in area of #205. T-12 returned to structure and made contact with MSU PD. There was a smell of something like paper burning in a conference room in #205. T-12 then noted that an Exit sign had some soot around it and it was inoperable. T-12 directed IPF to fix the unit. IPF opened the unit to find some charring from the electrical transformer within the sign. T-12 cleared and IPF 7 remained to fix the unit.

**August 12, 2018, 2:30 AM-** Dispatched to a structure fire on campus at Research Facility, a light was on fire and the barn contained over 40 cows, assigned Metro 1 by dispatch. No further updates by dispatch while enroute. E-12 was first to arrive with nothing visible, establishing command, and investigating. On my arrival, I assumed command, had T-11 stage on roadway and E-12 continue to investigate. E-12 reported no current fire, light ballast appeared to overheat and catch fire. MSU PD was on scene as well. E-12 requested T-11 crew to assist with checking for extension. Assigned T-11 to E-12 to check for extension. TIC was used, and no extension was noted. E-12 followed up with on scene staff, all other units cleared scene.

**August 13, 2018, 6:31 AM-** Dispatched for mutual aid to Meridian on possible garage fire. Enroute emergent from Station 2 with 4 aboard Engine 12. Advised to switch to Ingham Tac 1. Arrived on scene, assigned to level 1 stage by command. Cleared by command after a short wait, Engine 12 clear. Dispatched to mutual aid to MTFD for a structure fire. FF Phinney in the station and placed in the fourth seat on T11. Enroute, advised to switch to ING TAC 1. Arrived and told to go on deck, Alpha side. Stayed on deck until cleared by command.

**August 15, 2018, 8:05 AM-** Dispatched to a mulch fire. Arrived to South side of business and found an area of mulch soaked down with water. Occupant met us and stated he found a

smoldering fire this morning and used a hose from the carwash to saturate the mulch and extinguish the fire. He called us because he stated the ground felt hot after extinguishing the fire. We used a shovel to turn up the mulch in and around the area where the fire was burning. Found nothing smoldering underneath the mulch. Explained to him that the fire was just extinguished and the ground would remain warm for some time because the mulch was insulating the ground. He stated he would re-soak the area with water and keep an eye on it today. There was nothing obvious found that led to the initial fire.

**August 19, 2018, 7:50 PM-** Called top a propane grill tank on fire on a deck. ATF the fire was out, and appeared to be from a loose gas line from tank to valve. We turned tank valve off, tightened the line, and advised occupant to clean grill thoroughly before cooking again. She agreed and we cleared after getting contact info.

**August 24, 2018, 6:55 PM-** Dispatched for smoke alarm. ATF 3 story elderly living center (individual apartments) with nothing visible from exterior. T-11 investigating. Upon entering the structure, occupant of apartment 112 found us and reported she was seasoning a cast iron pan in her oven that set off her smoke alarm in her apartment. Occupant has already remedied the situation, by turning oven off filling pan with water and using fans for ventilation. The building fire alarm did not go off. Smoke has all but cleared. T-11 clears the scene.

**August 27, 2018, 8:05 AM-** Dispatched for general fire alarm at Fraternity. Initially T-11 responded with lights and sirens. Dispatch updated info said it was food on the stove and no fire. T-11 downgraded response priority and went normal traffic. Arrived found food on the stove, smoke was mostly cleared. Windows had been opened for ventilation. Alarm reset and information gathered.
